RECEIPT OF PROPOSALS

Sealed Proposals for the construction of the Stallings/Cedar Farms Wastewater Pump Station and Force Main, City Project No. Cl. 20002 will be received at the office of the City of Lebanon Public Services Commissioner, City of Lebanon Administration Building, 200 North Castle Heights Avenue, Suite 300, Lebanon, Tennessee 37087, Attention: Mr. Jeff Baines on or before 10:00 a.m. local time on Thursday, September 9, 2021, and immediately thereafter all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The project will include the following described construction:

The furnishing, installing, and testing of approximately 5,950 linear feet of 10-inch AWWA C-900, DR-18 (PR 235) PVC sewer force main, combination air and vacuum release valve manhole assemblies, unclassified excavation, backfill, tie-ins, fittings, installing force main in steel casings using tunnel/bore and open cut methods, installing casing pipes by tunnel/ bore method for proposed force main, installing detection tape with tracer wire and tracer stub boxes, new wastewater pumping station including site work, controls, electrical, valves, and working in close proximity with other utilities, stream crossings, no blasting provisions, sediment and erosion control measures, rip-rap streambank stabilization, traffic control, street barricades and signs in accordance with MUTCD, property restoration, pavement restoration, testing, and all other appurtenances and other work as shown on the Construction Drawings or indicated in the Contract Specifications.

Official (numbered) Bid Documents shall be obtained at the office of Water Management Services, LLC, 2 International Plaza, Suite 401, Nashville, Tennessee 37217 (telephone: 615-366-6088). A non-refundable deposit of \$100.00 must be made for each set obtained.

It is the policy of the City of Lebanon to ensure compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; 49 CFR, Part 21, related statutes and regulations to that end that no person shall be excluded from participation in or be denied benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance of any other funding source on the grounds of race, color, sex, national origin, or ancestry. By virtue of submitting a response to this solicitation, bidders agree to comply with the same non-discrimination policy.

Bid documents may be examined at Builder's Exchange of Tennessee, 301 S. Perimeter Park Drive, Suite 100, Office 9, Nashville, TN 37211, and the Nashville Contractors Association, 17430 Burlison Lane, Nashville, TN 37129.

Subject to the provisions of Chapter 6 of Title 62 of the Tennessee Codes Annotated, the Contractor's attention is directed to the Tennessee Codes Annotated Section 62-6-119 which states that it will be necessary for each bidder and their subcontractors to show evidence of a license before his bid will be considered and that the license number, expiration date, and that part of classification applying to the bid appear on the envelope containing the bid; otherwise the bid shall not be opened.

No bid shall be withdrawn after the opening of the proposals without the consent of the City of Lebanon, Tennessee, Department of Public Services for a period of ninety (90) days after the scheduled time of the closing of bids. The successful bidder shall be required to fully complete all work within 240 consecutive calendar days from and including the date to start work established in a written order from the City of Lebanon, Tennessee, Department of Public Services.

The City of Lebanon, Tennessee, Department of Public Services reserves the right to reject any Proposal for failure to comply with all requirements of the notice or of any of the Contract Documents; however, it may waive any minor defects or informalities at its discretion. The City of Lebanon, Tennessee, Department of Public Services further reserves the right to reject all Proposals. The Proposal must not be removed from the Contract Documents with which it has been bound by the City of Lebanon, Tennessee, Department of Public Services.
