GENERAL INFORMATION

Franklin County Sheriff's Office is seeking Bids for a 40 Ft. by 120 Ft. steel building. See attachment 2 for Example Drawing.

The site is currently cleared and leveled, but would need no more than 2 FT. of fill inside the foundation. Underground conduit is currently run to the building site.

SCHEDULE

The anticipated schedule for the building structure is immediately upon award of this RFB. Procurement of a building is paramount followed immediately by installation. All work needs to be complete prior to October 2022.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Building must be 40ft. by 120ft.
- 2. Building must have 16 ft. walls with a low slope gable roof.
- 3. The building must be equipped with five (5), 12ft. by 14ft. insulated garage doors-which would be located on the 120ft. side of the building along with one (1), 36 inch man door.
- 4. The interior of the building must have 3 inches of insulation on the walls and 6 inches of insulation on the ceiling at minimum.
- 5. Minimum lighting to illuminate the interior of the structure will be required.
- 6. Electrical outlets on the walls not to exceed 8 ft. separation around perimeter of the interior of the building.
- 7. Color choices for the exterior material must be provided to the Franklin County Sheriff's Office upon bid award and final decision made by the Sheriff.
- 8. The awarded vendor to provide all transport and hoisting for setting structure and provide any site work required for transport and hoisting for setting structure.
- 9. The awarded vendor to furnish and install all foundations for the building. The Floor of the building to be no less than 6 inches thick. Foundation base options to be provided to the Franklin County Sheriff's office and final decision made by the Sheriff.
- 10. The awarded vendor to provide weather protection for the building as needed.
- 11. The awarded vendor to furnish all necessary building permits.
- 12.It is the County expectation that the vendor will hold appropriate licenses/certifications for trade.

- 13. Site visit to the proposed building is required. See above for dates.
- 14. The awarded vendor to provide a time-line from awarding of the bid to completion of installation of the building.
- 15. Photos of Steel Building examples may be submitted along with the pricing form.

16. Prevailing Wage

- a.) Not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages, as set out in the wage order attached to and made part of the specification for work under the contract, shall be paid to all workers performing work under the contract. (Section 290.250, RSMo.)
- b.) The contractor will forfeit a penalty to the contracting public body of \$100 per day (or portion of a day) for each worker that is paid less than the prevailing rate for any work done under the contract by the contractor or by any subcontractor. (Section 290.250, RSMo).
- c.) The contractor and all subcontractors to the contract must require all on-site employees to complete the ten-hour construction safety training program required under Section 292.675, RSMo, unless they have previously completed the program and have documentation of having done so.
- d.) The contractor will forfeit a penalty to the contracting public body of \$2500 plus an additional \$100 for each employee employed by the contractor or subcontractor, for each calendar day, or portion thereof, such employee is employed without the required training. (Section 292.675, RSMo).

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Expectation of the County is that all components integral to the structure are fully functioning and operational upon arrival to the site. Vendor to provide an unconditional guarantee against defect of all workmanship, all equipment, and material for a period of one year from date of acceptance by the County.

The contents of this section include mandatory requirements that will be required of the successful bidder and subsequent contractor. The offeror is requested to provide responses to the requirements/desired attributes in this section pursuant to the directions identified herein. The offeror's response, whether responding to a mandatory requirement or a desired attribute, shall be binding in the event the bid is accepted by Franklin County. The offeror must provide all costs necessary to meet the mandatory requirements and the fulfillment of any desirable attributes in the appropriate section titled Pricing.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The Contractor shall furnish County with a certificate of insurance indicating proof of the following insurance from company's license in the State of Missouri:
 - A. Worker's Compensation and Employers' Liability: Worker's Compensation Statutory in compliance with the Compensation law of the Sate and Employers' Liability Insurance with a limit no less than \$1,000,000.00 each accident.
 - B. Comprehensive or Commercial General Liability with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, \$3,000,000.00 aggregate combined Single Limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability. This insurance shall include, but not be limited to, the following coverage.
 - 1. Premises Operations
 - 2. Products and Completed Operations
 - 3. Broad Form Property Damage
 - 4. Contractual
 - 5. Personal Injury

C. Automobile Liability with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, \$3,000,000.00 aggregate Combined Single Limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability. This insurance shall include coverage for all the following:

- 1. Owned Automobiles
- 2. Hired Automobiles
- 3. Non-Owned Automobiles
- D. The certificate shall list the Certificate Holder and Address as follows: Franklin County, 400 E Locust Street, Room 206, Union, Mo 63084. The services provided to Franklin County shall be listed under "Description of Operations."
- E. Such insurance shall include under the General Liability and Automobile Liability policies Franklin County, its employees, elected officials, representatives, and members of its board and/or commissioners as "Additional Insured's".
- 2. The Agreement of Insurance shall provide for notice to the County of amendment or cancellation of insurance policies 30 days before such amendment or cancellation is to take effect.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

Anti-Discrimination Against Israel Act Requirement



OVERTIME and HOLIDAYS

OVERTIME

For all work performed on a Sunday or a holiday, not less than twice (2x) the prevailing hourly rate of wages for work of a similar character in the locality in which the work is performed or the public works contracting minimum wage, whichever is applicable, shall be paid to all workers employed by or on behalf of any public body engaged in the construction of public works, exclusive of maintenance work.

For all overtime work performed, not less than one and one-half (1½) the prevailing hourly rate of wages for work of a similar character in the locality in which the work is performed or the public works contracting minimum wage, whichever is applicable, shall be paid to all workers employed by or on behalf of any public body engaged in the construction of public works, exclusive of maintenance work or contractual obligation. For purposes of this subdivision, "overtime work" shall include work that exceeds ten hours in one day and work in excess of forty hours in one calendar week; and

A thirty-minute lunch period on each calendar day shall be allowed for each worker on a public works project, provided that such time shall not be considered as time worked.
