1.0 GENERAL INFORMATION

This specification is for the purchase of four (4) knife gate valves to replace the existing valves and for use with the existing actuation equipment. The Moccasin Bend Wastewater Treatment Plant currently uses four DeZurik knife gate valves to control the flow at the wet weather grit removal tanks. This specification describes the type of knife gate valve replacement needed and is for the valve only. The City is taking bids on four (4) replacement knife gate valves.

The existing Dezurik valves have the following information on the nameplate:

2.0 GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS KNIFE GATE VALVE

2.1 36" valves shall be model KGC-ES Cast Knife Gate Valves as manufactured by DeZURIK ES model (extended service life). See Drawing K15385 dated 8/19/2018 for detailed specifications on valve requirements. The drawing is a part of these specifications.

2.2 Valve shall be the bonnetless knife gate type.

2.3 Gate side edges shall be machined, finished and rounded. The bottom edge shall have a 45-degree beveled knife edge. The gate faces shall be finish ground.

2.4 Packing System shall fit a rounded machined packing chamber. The Packing System shall consist of multiple layers of packing with an anti-extrusion ring. The selected packing system shall be for wet service. Packing gland material shall match the valve body. Fasteners shall be stainless steel.

2.5 Body shall be a one-piece casting of type 304 stainless steel. Valve body shall incorporate cast-in guides and jams and can handle full reverse pressure without damage. Valve inside port diameter shall be equal to ASME B36.10 Standard pipe inside diameter. Raised faces shall be full width per ASME B16.20 standards for spiral-wound gaskets.

2.6 Seat shall be resilient material. Resilient seat material shall be molded on three sides of the stainless steel seat ring. Resilient seat material shall be CR (Chloroprene).

2.7 Face-to-face dimension shall match existing valves and are 4.63". To assure this dimension is provided, "P100" must be included in the valve description.

2.8 Cold Working Pressure valve rating shall be 100 psi (690 kPa).

2.9 Flange drilling shall be in accordance with ASME 16.47 Series A class 150.

2.10 Actuation. Superstructure shall be carbon steel material. An extension adapter must be provided to connect with existing actuator.

2.11 Warranty Valves and actuators shall be warranted by the manufacturer for defects in materials and workmanship for a period of two years (24 months) from the date of shipment.

2.12 Shipping. Vendor shall include all shipping cost in bid and state delivery time after receipt of PO.

3.0 REFERENCE SPECIFICATIONS, CODES AND STANDARDS

The knife gate valves shall comply with the current provisions of the following standards:

1. MSS SP-81 Metal Seated Valves
2. ASME B16.20.
