Any party who is in active litigation with Highlands County on the due date for responses to this solicitation/proposal/quote or who has received notice from Highlands County that the party is in breach of a contractual obligation under a contract with Highlands County and where such breach has not been resolved to the satisfaction of Highlands County on the due date for responses to this solicitation/proposal/quote, shall not submit a response to this solicitation/proposal/quote. In the event of a submission by such a party as described hereinabove, the submission shall be considered non-responsible and shall be rejected.

2. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

By submitting a response to this Request for FWQ, the vendor agrees to the following requirements, which shall be included in any purchase order issued pursuant to this Request:

- 3.1 The vendor shall hold all licenses and certifications and comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations applicable to the work required to perform this purchase order. Any of the vendor's personnel who perform services shall be lawfully licensed and certified. Damages, penalties, and fines imposed on County or vendor resulting from vendor's failure to obtain and maintain required licenses and certifications shall be borne by vendor. All fees, permits, certifications, and licenses are the responsibility of the vendor and are included in the quoted price.
- 3.2 All reports, specifications, documents, plans, analyses, and other data and work product developed by vendor under this purchase order shall be delivered to County at any time upon its request and shall become the property of County upon payment of the agreed upon price without restrictions or limitations.
- 3.3 The vendor shall coordinate with the Requesting/User Department prior to commencing any and all work required to perform this purchase order.
- 3.4 Unless otherwise provided in this purchase order, upon satisfactory completion and delivery of all work or goods to the County pursuant to this purchase order, the County shall pay the amount of the purchase order to the vendor in accordance with Board's Prompt Payment Policy and the Local Government Prompt Payment Act, Section 218.70 et. seq., Florida Statutes. Satisfactory completion shall be determined by Project Manager.
- 2.5 If any litigation is commenced between the parties concerning the work to be performed or goods to be delivered pursuant to this purchase order or the parties' respective rights and duties under this purchase order, the prevailing party may recover reasonable attorney's fees and costs of litigation, in addition to other relief granted. Venue for any legal action shall lie in Highlands County, Florida, and any proceedings to enforce or interpret any provision of this purchase order shall be brought exclusively in a court of competent jurisdiction in Highlands County, Florida.
- 3.6 No delay or failure by either party to exercise any right, and no partial or single exercise of any right, shall constitute a waiver of that or any other right.

- 3.7 Rights and obligations shall be construed in accordance with and governed by the laws of the State of Florida.
- 3.8 Failure of the vendor to comply with the requirements of this purchase order shall constitute a breach of contract. A purchase order may be issued to the vendor that submitted the next lowest/available FWQ with the difference in price being paid by the vendor issued this purchase order.
- 3.9 The vendor shall not assign, transfer, convey, sublet or sell any portion of this purchase order or the performance thereof unless written consent is given, in advance, by the Project Manager.
- 3.10 The vendor shall be responsible for disposal of all material requiring disposal and shall show proof of disposal at an authorized landfill prior to submitting an invoice or other request for payment, if applicable.
- 2.11 Until final payment is received by the vendor from the County pursuant to this purchase order, the vendor shall maintain in force and effect the following insurance for the work to be performed or goods to be delivered pursuant to this purchase order:
 - 2.11.1 **Commercial General Liability** coverage shall provide minimum limits of liability of \$1,000,000 per occurrence Combined Single Limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage, including coverage for:
 - * Premises/Operations
- * Products/Completed Operations
- * Broad Form Contractual Liability * Independent Contractors
- 2.11.2 **Business Auto Liability** coverage shall provide minimum limits of liability of \$500,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage, including coverage for liability arising out of any auto, including owned, hired, and non-owned autos.
- 2.11.3 **Workers' Compensation** coverage must meet statutory limits in compliance with the Workers' Compensation Law of Florida. This policy must include Employer Liability with a limit \$500,000 for each accident.
- 3.12 The vendor shall deliver a completed W-9 form to the County, within ten (10) days after the purchase order is issued, unless it already done so.
- 3.13 The vendor shall be prepared to start providing services within the time stated in this purchase order. Failure to complete the work or deliver goods as scheduled may result in written notice to the vendor terminating its right to proceed. Should the vendor be unable to complete the services or deliver the goods within the scheduled time, the County may use the services or goods provided by another vendor. The difference in the contracted price for the services or delivery of the goods and that paid the new vendor for the services or goods shall be charged to and paid by vendor to whom this purchase order was issued by set-off against any amount owed by the County to that vendor or, if none, shall be paid by that vendor to the County within twenty (20) days after being invoiced by the County.
- 3.14 The County is a political subdivision of the State of Florida and is not subject to federal excise tax or state sales or use tax. The vendor shall not add taxes of any kind to the cost of services or goods or invoice to or collect from the County any federal excise tax or state sales or use tax.
- 2.15 If by providing services to the County pursuant to this purchase order the vendor

- is a contractor, as defined by Section 119.0701, Florida Statutes, the vendor shall:
- 2.15.1 Keep and maintain public records required by the County to perform the services.
- 2.15.2 Upon request of the County's custodian of public records, provide the County with a copy of the requested records or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time at the cost that does not exceed the cost Provided in Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, or as otherwise provided by law.
- 2.15.3 Ensure that public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements are not disclosed except as authorized by law for the duration of the term of this contract and following competition of this contract if vendor does not transfer the records to the County.
- 2.15.4 Upon competition of performance of services required by this purchase order, transfer to the County, at no cost, all public records in possession of vendor or keep and maintain public records required by the County to perform the services. If the vendor transfers all public records to the County upon competition of the performance of services required by this purchase order, the vendor shall destroy any duplicate public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements. If the vendor keeps and maintains public records upon completion of performance of services required by this purchase order, the vendor shall meet all applicable requirements for retaining public records. All records stored electronically must be provided to the County upon request from the County's custodian of public records, in a format that is compatible with the information technology systems of the County.

4. SPECIFICATIONS:

- 4.1 TERM: The successful bidder shall be responsible for furnishing and delivering to the County's requesting Department(s) the commodity or services on an "as needed basis." The initial term of the Contract shall be for one (1) year from the date of the Recommendation for Award. Upon mutual agreement of the parties, may be renewed for three (3) one (1) year terms, at the same pricing and terms and conditions set forth in the FWQ. The agreement may not exceed \$50,000 for the life of the contract. Services may be terminated with a 30-day notice.
- 4.2 AWARD: Shall be based on the lowest responsive and responsible quote. This quote will be awarded on Grand Total price (per attached list) and the best interest of the County.
- 4.3 INVOICING / COMPENSATION: Contractor will hold pricing for up to 120 days from date of opening or Recommendation for Award, whichever is later, while project is approved. Contractor shall submit detailed invoices identifying the Purchase Order number, location, and work completed. The invoice must be submitted to the department identified on the Purchase Order. If there are any apparent defects in the work or material, County will promptly notify Contractor. Without limiting any other rights to which it may be entitled, County may require Contractor, at Contractor's expense, to correct any nonconforming workmanship.
- 4.4 SCOPE OF WORK: Highlands County Board of County Commissioners (County) is seeking pricing for annual fire extinguisher service and certification for Class A, B, C fire extinguishers

This service is to include all types and styles. Therefore, it is requested that quotes for these services include all items listed on the attachments. Annual inspection presently is completed as needed, bi-annually on all extinguishers and it is our intention to continue with that time frame.

NOTE: Inspection to meet all compliance requirements and prices are to be all-inclusive. To include, but not limited to, tags, labels, seals, pull pins, handles, tamper devices, fusible links and all other material to bring extinguishing system up to NFPA compliance.

- 3.5. All recharges must be done to the manufacturer's specifications. The use of generic chemicals or parts shall not be used. Universal mounting hardware may be used if requested by the County for use in special situations.
- 3.6. LOCATION: For trip charges, if applicable, the county is divided into three quadrants.
 - 3.6.1. North County: Hwy 66/98 North to County line.
 - 3.6.2. Central County: between Hwy 66/98 & Hwy 70.
 - 3.6.3. South County: Hwy 70 South to County line.

- 3.7. REQUIREMENTS OF QUOTE SUBMITTAL: (All documents must be included with your price quote sheet to be considered for Award)
 - 3.7.1. Give an explanation of how recharging extinguishers is to be accomplished.
 - 3.7.2. Awarded vendor shall complete an assessment of all buildings for the correct type and number of fire extinguishers during the recertification period which is in the month of **March**. This should be at no charge to the County, if there is a charge, you must incorporate that charge into the recertification fee.
 - 3.7.3. Describe how temporary replacements will be provided until the recharged and recertified extinguisher is returned.
 - 3.7.4. Permit or certification of all service technicians that will be performing the services and if new employees are hired, their permit shall be submitted at that time.
 - 3.7.5. Provide Florida Department of Financial Services Division of State Fire Marshal: Class A Fire Equipment Dealer License. To include service, recharge, repair, install or inspect all types of Fire Extinguishers including recharging carbon dioxide units.
