Section 1 – Introduction

Effingham County Board of Commissioners are accepting sealed bids from respondents interested in purchasing pecan trees located on the County's "Proposed Recreation Complex Property" in accordance with the specifications, terms and conditions shown in this invitation for the sale of surplus property.

A total of eighteen (18) pecan trees are available for purchase.

The successful respondent(s) shall be responsible for the extraction/removal and transportation of the trees, and clean up associated with the extraction/removal of the trees. Stumps can remain.

All pecan trees sold must be completely removed from the site no later than **5.00pm** (local time) Friday September 2nd, 2016. If the trees are not removed by **5.00pm** (local time) Friday September 2nd, 2016, the successful bidder agrees to forfeit all rights to the trees back to the County.

The property is located at 1750 Hwy 21 S, Springfield, GA 31329.

Section 2 - Instructions to Bidders

1. General Information

2. Scope

The highest bidder will have the option of purchasing all eighteen (18) trees. Should the highest bidder choose not to purchase all eighteen (18) trees, the next highest bidder will have the option of purchasing the remaining tress. This process will be completed until all trees have been sold.

3. Terms and Conditions Applicable to Sale

- a. The property is being offered and will be sold "as is", "where is" and "with all faults".
- b. Any and all property inspections must be completed before the date of the bid opening.

4. Property Inspection:

Bidders can inspect the trees at 1750 Hwy 21 S, Springfield, GA 31329. Bidders inspect the trees at their own risk.

5. Questions and Answers

Any questions regarding the bid documents or the bid process that are not answered in the invitation to bid shall be directed in writing to the Purchasing Agent. Questions may be emailed to fcharleton@effinghamcounty.org, or faxed to 912-754-8413. Responses will only be made to written questions, and will be made in writing. No responses will be given to verbal questions.

The only official answer or position of Effingham County will be the one stated in writing.

6. Preparation and Submission of Sealed Bids

Bid forms must be submitted in accordance with the following instructions:

- a. Bidders shall submit one (1) original Bid. A completed Bid consists of the following documents listed below, duly executed as appropriate:
 - Bid Schedule must use form attached
 - Notarized Non Collusion Affidavit form attached
 - Notarized Hold Harmless Agreement form attached
- b. Documents shall be signed and dated in blue ink. All blank spaces must be typed or handwritten in blue ink. Any corrections to any entry must be lined out and initialed by the Bidder. Use of correction tape or fluids is prohibited.
- c. Bids must be submitted in sealed opaque envelope and plainly marked <u>ITB No. 17-003 Sale of Surplus Pecan Trees.</u>
- d. Bids can be mailed to or hand delivered to the address on the cover page of this ITB.
- 7. Withdrawal of Bids Bids may not be withdrawn once they have been received and opened by the County.

8. Bid Closing

The bid closes on Wednesday August 10th at 10.00am (local time). Any bid received after the stated date and time shall not be considered. It shall be the sole responsibility of the bidder to have their bid delivered on or before the stated date and time. If a bid is sent by the U.S. mail, or by any courier delivery service the bidder shall be responsible for its timely delivery to the Purchasing Department. Bids delayed for any reason will not be considered or opened, and will be returned to the bidder at their request and expense.

9. Right to Reject Bids

The County reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Any and all bids may be rejected if they are deemed in the judgment of the County to be non-responsive to the Invitation to Bid.

10. Applicable Laws

All applicable laws and regulations of the State of Georgia and ordinances and policies of Effingham County shall apply.

11. Basis of Award

The award shall be made to the highest bidder. All bids may be rejected if they are deemed in the judgment of the Purchasing Agent to be non-responsive to the Invitation to bids.

The winning bidder(s) will be informed as soon as the bids have been tabulated – no later than close of business on **Wednesday August 10th**, 2016.

5.	Attorneys' Fees and Costs. If any legal action or other proceeding is brought in connection with this Agreement, the successful or prevailing Party, if any, shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorneys' fees and other related costs, in addition to any other relief to which that Party is entitled. In the event that it is the subject of dispute, the court or trier of fact who presides over such legal action or proceeding is empowered to determine which Party, if any, is the prevailing party in accordance with this provision.
6.	Entire Agreement. This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the Parties related to the matters specified herein, and supersedes any prior oral or written statements or agreements between the Parties related to such matters.
7.	Enforceability, Severability, and Reformation. If any provision of this Agreement shall be held to be

provision it would become valid and enforceable, then such provision shall be deemed to be written,

invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions shall continue to be valid and enforceable. If a court finds that any provision of this Agreement is invalid or unenforceable, but that by limiting such

- **8. Applicable Law.** This Agreement shall be governed exclusively by the laws of Georgia, without regard to conflict of law provisions.
- 9. Exclusive Venue and Jurisdiction. Any lawsuit or legal proceeding arising out of or relating to this Agreement in any way whatsoever shall be exclusively brought and litigated in the federal and state courts of Georgia, Each Party expressly consents and submits to this exclusive jurisdiction and exclusive venue. Each Party expressly waives the right to challenge this jurisdiction and/or venue as improper or inconvenient. Each Party consents to the dismissal of any lawsuit that they bring in any other jurisdiction or venue.
