Answers to Questions

1. It is noted on page 5 of the solicitation, that we are to initial at the bottom of each page of the solicitation. Does this need to be added as an appendix section so that it does not exceed the 20 page limit?

As noted on page 10 of the RFQ, there are three documents that must be submitted:

- 1. RFQ (initialed at bottom of each page by firm's representative)
- 2. Statement of Qualifications (not-to-exceed 20 pages)
- 3. Mandatory Vendor Submittal Form (one page)
- 2. Do the vendor submittal and addenda acknowledgement forms count against the 20 page limit?
