Filter Analysis for PM_{2.5} Monitoring

This contract will be for pre-drying, pre-weighing, and post-drying and post-weighing 47mm Teflon PM_{2.5} filters to 3 decimal places (0.001). The work must be done in a temperature and humidity controlled, static-free laboratory environment according to Part 40 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*; EPA's *QA Handbook for Air Pollution Measurement Systems: Volume II: Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Program* EPA-454/B-17-001; and EPA's Quality Assurance Guidance Document 2.12, *Monitoring PM_{2.5} in Ambient Air Using Designated Reference or Class I Equivalent Methods* EPA 454/B-16-001.

In AQ Guidance Document 2.12, the applicable parts and sections are specifically: Chapter 9, Gravimetric Laboratory Design and Setup; Chapter 10, Filter Preparation and Analysis; Chapter 11, Performance Evaluation Section 11.2.7 Balance Accuracy Assessment and Section 11.2.8 Temperature and Relative Humidity Logger Audit Procedure; and Chapter 12 Calculations, Validations, and Reporting of PM_{2.5} Section 12.2.2 Net PM_{2.5} Mass Calculation and Section 12.2.3. PM_{2.5} Concentration Calculation.

The contract lab will be responsible for any discussion in the Handbook or Guidance that is applicable to laboratory procedures, but not specifically named in this document.

Filters: Supply and Preparation –

EPA will supply the filters to the Chattanooga-Hamilton County Air Pollution Control Bureau (the Bureau) who will forward them to the lab. The filters will be pre-dried, pre-weighed, loaded into clean cassettes, and mailed by the lab to the Bureau for exposure in the field. The Bureau will mail the exposed cassettes back to the laboratory on cold packs in a cooler with a digital thermometer that records the maximum and minimum temperatures. The filters will be removed from the cassettes, re-dried, and re-weighed within 30 days of exposure.

Shipping Fees –

This contract will include shipment costs of any filters or items sent to the Bureau by the contract laboratory.

The contract laboratory will not be responsible for shipment fees for any shipment from the Bureau to the contract laboratory. Shipment fees for any filters or items sent to the contract laboratory from the Bureau will be paid by the Bureau.

Cassettes Care and Cleaning Procedure –

Cassettes that hold the filters shall be cleaned with alcohol, acetone, or mild soap and water and dried by the laboratory before a new filter is loaded. Care should be taken to prevent any contamination of the cassettes.

The lab will ship loaded cassettes to the Bureau every two to three weeks as needed. The Bureau will ship the exposed cassettes back to the lab every two to three weeks.

Reporting –

This contract will include providing two reports per quarter: a report where data is in a readable format with weights and calculated $PM_{2.5}$ values for each site and a report where data lines have been put into pipe delimited Air Quality System (AQS) loadable format with all four required lines. The lines are 88101, 68102, 68105, and 68108 for each run day formatted from the weights of filters and monitor downloads. The AQS format shall include void lines and blank data. The laboratory will add any necessary flags to the loadable AQS data lines when and if such is required.

The Bureau will e-mail the downloaded data from the $PM_{2.5}$ Federal Reference Monitors to the lab.

Temperature and Humidity Control Charts –

Temperature and humidity control charts will be provided to the Bureau to demonstrate that the laboratory temperature and humidity have been properly controlled. Any laboratory deviation from the quality assurance requirements must be immediately reported to the Bureau.

Cassette Shipping –

The Bureau will ship cassettes in plastic petri dishes sealed with vinyl tape. The plastic petri dishes and vinyl tape will be supplied by the Bureau to the contract lab. The Bureau will send triplicate blanks (loaded cassettes mailed from the laboratory that are never opened) to the laboratory. If the triplicate blanks indicate numbers higher than 0.010, the laboratory will be contacted and response action will be expected to try to lower the difference in pre and post weights.

This contract will, at a minimum, be annually renewable for not less than a five year period with no appreciable rate increase.

Affirmative Action Plan

The City of Chattanooga is an equal opportunity employer and during the performance of this Contract, the Contractor agrees to abide by the equal opportunity goals of the City of Chattanooga as follows:

1. The Contractor will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, or handicap. The Contractor will send to each labor union or representative of workers with which he/she has a collective bargaining agreement or other contract or understanding, a notice advising the said labor union or workers' representatives of the Contractor's commitments under this section, and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.
4. In all construction contracts or subcontracts in excess of \$10,000 to be performed for the City of Chattanooga, any contractor and/or subcontractor is further required to file in duplicate within ten (10) days of being notified that it is the lowest responsible bidder, an affirmative action plan with the EEO Director of the City of Chattanooga. This plan shall state the Contractor's goals for minority and women utilization as a percentage of the work force on this project.
5. This Plan or any attachments thereto shall further provide a list of all employees annotated by job function, race, and sex who are expected to be utilized on this project. This plan or attachment thereto shall further describe the methods by which the Contractor or Subcontractor will utilize to make good faith efforts at providing employment opportunities for minorities and women.

During the term of this contract, the Contractor upon request of the City, will make available for inspection by the City of Chattanooga copies of payroll records, personnel documents and similar records or documents that may be used to verify the Contractor's compliance with these Equal Opportunity provisions.

6. The Contractor will include the portion of the sentence immediately preceding paragraph 1 and the provisions of paragraphs 1 through 6 in every subcontract so that such provisions will be requested of each subcontractor. The Contractor agrees to notify the City of Chattanooga of any subcontractor who refuses or fails to comply with these equal opportunity provisions. Any failure or refusal to comply with these provisions the Contractor and/or Subcontractor shall be a breach of this contract.
