#### **BID NOTICE**

Union County EMS will be accepting sealed bids for new GMC Type I Ambulance two wheel drive remount. Sealed proposals must be submitted to Union County Finance Office, 300 Main Street, Maynardville, TN 37807 ATTN: BID 0027-Remount. Proposals will be accepted until 3:00 p.m. February 22, 2016 at the Finance Office location. Submissions will be opened immediately following the close of the bids. Bids will not be awarded until the bids have been reviewed for compliance and approved Union County reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

#### SECTION 1 - GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- **1.1** <u>ALTERATIONS OR AMENDMENTS</u>: Alterations, amendments, changes, modifications or additions to this solicitation shall not be binding on Union County without prior written approval.
- **1.2 NO CONTACT POLICY**: After vendor receives a copy of this bid, any contact initiated by any vendor with any Union County representative, other than the Finance Department, concerning this invitation for bid is prohibited and agreements made thereto will not be considered binding on Union County. Any such unauthorized contact may cause the disqualification of the bidder from this procurement transaction.
- **1.3** <u>OUESTIONS</u>: Any questions concerning the bid document must be submitted to <u>purchasing@unioncountytn.org</u> no less than ninety-six (96) hours before bid opening date.
- 1.4 BID STAMP: The bid/time stamp in the Union County Finance office will be the time of record.
- **1.5 TAXES:** Union County is not liable for Federal excise or State sales tax. Tax exemption certificates will be provided upon request.
- **1.6\_CONFLICT OF INTEREST**: If requested by the Director of Finance, vendors must complete and submit a "Conflict of Interest Affidavit Statement" prior to contract award, see T.C.A. 5-14-114 and T. C. A. 12-4-101.
- 1.7 NON-COLLUSION: Vendors, by submitting a signed bid, certify that the accompanying bid is not the result of, or affected by, any unlawful act of collusion with any other person or company engaged in the same line of business or commerce, or any other fraudulent act punishable under Tennessee or United States law.
- **1.8 NON-DISCRIMINATION:** Vendors, during the performance of this contract, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, religion, sex, national origin or disability except where religion, sex, national origin or disability is a bona fide occupational qualification reasonably necessary to the normal operation of the contractor.
- **1.9 SAME AS OR EQUIVALENT TO:** Vendors are to bid as specified herein or propose an approved equal. Determination of equality is solely Union County's responsibility. The designated brands are for reference purpose only, not a statement of preference. When an alternate manufacturer, brand, model or make is bid, Union County will determine if the item bid does meet or exceed the items as specified. If the bidder does not indicate that an alternate manufacturer, brand, model or make is being bid, it is understood that the item(s) bid are the same manufacturer, brand, model or make as was requested in the Invitation to Bid. Comparable products of other manufacturers will be considered if proof of comparability is contained in the bid. It shall be the responsibility of the vendors, including vendors whose product is referenced to furnish upon request catalog pages, brochures or other data as will provide an adequate basis for determining the quality and functional capabilities of the product offered. Failure to provide this data may be considered valid justification for rejection of bid.
- **1.10** MULTIPLE BIDS/AWARDS: Union County will consider multiple bids that meet specifications. Bid awards may include multiple approved vendors and the list of approved vendors may be added to or deleted from at anytime.
- 1.11 STATE OF TENESSEE CONTRACTORS' LICENSE LAW (T.C.A. 62-6-119 b): No bid will be opened or considered for which the total cost of the project is twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) or more, unless the outside of the sealed bid envelope/package containing the bid provides the following information: the Company Name, the Contractor's license number, license classification, the date of the license expiration and that part of each license classification applying to the bid. In addition, each heating ventilation or air conditioning, plumbing and electrical subcontractor's license number, date of the license expiration and that part of each classification applying to the bid if the value of the work is \$25,000 or greater, must be notated. If the value of either the contractor or the subcontractor's work is less than \$25,000, the bid envelope/package containing the bid is to be notated with the phrase "Contractor or Subcontractor's Bid is Less than \$25,000" after each appropriate heading. - **1.12** ACCEPTANCE: Vendors shall hold their price firm and subject to acceptance by Union County for a minimum period of sixty (60) working days from the date of the bid opening, unless otherwise indicated in their bid. to be supplied, their conformity with specifications, their suitability to the requirements of Union County and the delivery terms. Any or all bids may be rejected for good cause.

- **1.13 BID AWARDS:** Bids will be awarded to the lowest and best bidder, taking into consideration the qualities of the articles to be supplied, their conformity with specifications, their suitability to the requirements of Union County and the delivery terms. Union County also reserves the right to not award this bid.
- **1.14 PROTEST:** Any vendor wishing to protest the bid award shall notify in writing the Union County Director of Finance, 300 Main Street, Maynardville TN 37807. No protest will be accepted, except those protests made in writing and received within (10) ten calendar days of the bid award. Protests must be in writing and envelopes/package containing protest must be clearly marked with bid number and words "BID PROTEST". The Director of Finance, in conjunction with the Finance Committee, and with the advice and counsel of the County Attorney, shall review and make a final decision as to any bid protest. Appeals shall be filed in the Circuit or Chancery Courts of Union County within sixty (60) days of the final decision.

- **1.15 <u>DELIVERY:</u>** Bid pricing is to include complete supply and delivery to Union County, Tennessee. Vendors are to state the delivery time in the bid. Union County requires that vendors deliver all products "free on board" to final destination unless indicated otherwise in their bid, reference Terms & Conditions section 2.4.
- **1.16 PROOF OF FINANCIAL AND BUSINESS CAPABILITY:** Bidders must, upon the request of Union County, provide satisfactory evidence of their ability to furnish products or services in accordance with the terms and conditions of these specifications. Union County will make the final determination as to the bidder's ability.
- **1.17 <u>VENDOR'S DEFAULT:</u>** Union County reserves the right, in case of vendor default, to procure the articles or services from other sources and hold the defaulting vendor responsible for any excess costs occasioned thereby.
- **1.18 <u>DUPLICATE COPIES</u>**: Union County requires that all vendors submit one original and one exact copy of their bids, including brochures; unless additional copies are requested in bid specifications.
- **1.19 DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE:** Under the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated §50-9-113 enacted by the General Assembly effective 2001, all employers with five (5) or more employees who contract with either the state or a local government to provide construction services are required to submit an affidavit stating that they have a drug free workplace program that complies with Title 50, Chapter 9, in effect at the time of submission of a bid at least to the extent required of governmental entities. #### REMOUNT SPECIFICATIONS FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE VEHICLE

#### 1.0 SCOPE, PURPOSE AND CLASSIFICATION

- Scope: This specification covers the remounting and refurbishment of a commercially produced, surfaced medical care vehicle, hereinafter referred to as an ambulance or vehicle. A vehicle in compliance with this specification shall be defined as a standard ambulance. This vehicle shall be in accordance with the Ambulance Design Criteria if the National Highway Traffic Administration, U.S. Department of Transportation, Washington D.C. This bid specification is based on the most current Federal Ambulance Specification KKK-A-1822.
- **Purpose:** The purpose of this document is to provide minimum specifications and test parameters for the remounting and refurbishment of an emergency medical care vehicle that meets the needs and desires of this agency. It establishes essential criteria for the design, performance, equipment and appearance of the vehicle. The object is to provide a vehicle that is in accordance with nationally recognized guidelines. It is the intent to return the unit to new or like new condition per the specification.
- **Classifications:** This specification calls for the following type of vehicle. It is in accordance with latest KKK-A-1822 standard.

Type I – Cab Chassis with modular ambulance body

Class 2 – Two rear wheel driven (4x2)

Configuration A (ALS) – Elevating cot and squad bench (3.1.5.1)

- 1.4 General: This is an engineer, design, construct and deliver type specification and it is not the intention of this agency to write out vendors of similar or equal equipment of the types specified. It should be noted, however, that this specification is written around specific needs of this agency. With the intent to standardize certain components, therefore in numerous places we have named specific brands of components. This has been done to establish a certain standard of quality. Other brands will only be accepted providing the vendor provides documentation in the bid that the particular brand offered meets or exceeds the quality of the actual brand called for in the specification.
- Materials: The emergency medical care vehicle, chassis, ambulance body, equipment, devices, medical accessories and electronic equipment to be delivered under this contract shall be standard commercial products, which meet of exceed the requirements of this specification. The ambulance shall comply with all Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (FMVSS), the Federal regulations applicable or specified for the year of manufacture. The chassis, components and optional items shall be as represented in the manufacturer's current technical data. Materials used in the construction shall be new and not less than the quality conforming to current engineering and manufacturing practices. Materials shall be free of defects and suitable for the service intended.
- Manufacturing Ability: It is the intent of these specifications that the Remounter of this vehicle(s) has the ability to remount and refurbish a complete ambulance within their plant facility, except for the chassis. The Ambulance Remounter must have significant experience in remounting and refurbishment of modular ambulance bodies and have performed a minimum of 100 remounts in the last five years. In addition, the Bidder/manufacturer must include with this bid, proof of \$10,000,000.00 product liability.

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In addition, the Bidder must provide proof they are a member of the Ford QVM program.

**Exceptions to Specifications:** Any exceptions to these specifications indicated must be clearly pointed out. Otherwise, it will be considered that the items offered are in strict compliance with these specifications and the successful bidder will be held responsible for delivering a vehicle meeting these specifications. Any exceptions must reference by Paragraph Number and Line and explain in detail on a separate sheet marked "Exceptions". Any bidder not complying shall not be considered as responsive.

Any Proposal which indicates "NO EXCEPTION" to any item on our proposal documents, and also includes a letter from the vendor taking major or total exception to our specifications or indicates they are quoting to provide their standard methods of construction without listing any differences in the manner described, will be immediately rejected as non-compliant and removed from further consideration.

Should a vendor offer a quotation in response to this proposal and not take explicit exceptions and attempt to offer a unit not in compliance with the exact specifications, the Purchaser reserves the sole right to issue a Purchase Order with specified penalties and/or invoke a Performance Bond. **1.8** Prices and Payments: All bid prices shall be complete and include warranty and delivery of the completed vehicle to this agency.

Payment shall be made in accordance with these specifications and the Bid Proposal submitted by the Bidder. Payment will be made upon acceptance of the vehicle(s) and equipment specified under these specifications.

All bid prices and conditions must be specified on the Bid Proposal Form. Bid prices shall be valid for at least 60 days from the date of the Bid Opening, or otherwise specified on the Bid Proposal Form.

**1.9 Warranty:** The successful bidder shall provide a remounter's warranty coverage for the ambulance or rescue vehicle conversion, which coverage shall, at a minimum include:

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1.9.1 A limited Warranty shall be provided in the ambulance remount conversion. The remounter shall warranty to the original retail purchaser that, for a period of sixty (60) months or sixty thousand (60,000) miles from the point of delivery, whichever first occurs, the ambulance remount shall be free of substantial defects in remount materials and remount workmanship, which are attributable to Warrantor remount work and which arise during the course of normal use and service. There shall be a copy of the Warranty statement included in the bid documents. NO EXCEPTIONS.
