1..Does HKT use their softball and baseball fields..photos show to be grown over on baseball and softball

A: Yes HKT does use their baseball and softball fields. We are currently skinning them

A: Only football practice fields are to be included for some services

3...are we to assume the initial bid will be standard prescription, regardless of beginning shape of fields

7...are we to assume that all turf areas are to be top dressed every season?

A: No, fields that do not have irrigation should not be overseeded.

8.... chemicals applied are to be a generic prescription for all fields

A: For the most part yes....depending on the type of chemicals used as long as the are approved for use in school areas

9...will are turfed areas be overseeded with perennial ryegrass every winter?

A: No

10...will we be responsible for soil test and admendments to correct soil deficiencies?

A: Soil test will be requested as needed. If there is an issue we would have to price that out.

11. Do all fields (besides practice fields) need to be overseeded? I know sometimes soccer is played on football fields, but not every school may have soccer.

A: Not all fields will be overseeded because you need irrigation to support preforming this service.

12. Is there a specific rate that the district would like for overseeding? My bid material pricing really depends on the rate because seed can be pretty expensive. My rate for overseeding is no less than 400 lbs/Acre. I highly suggest that as the recommended rate. That way all fields get plenty of ryegrass coverage. Rates lower than that can look patchy and thin.

A: Overseeding will be priced per Acre

13. Fields without irrigation will be very difficult to properly grow ryegrass. Should I just continue with the overseeding on those fields like I would the ones with irrigation?

A: Overseeding will be done per request....non irrigated fields will not be overseeded
