





SPECIFICATIONS

Preformed Speed Cushions (Revised: 1/04/18)

GENERAL

This specification describes and defines a preformed speed cushion. In order to consistently meet the following specifications, any manufacturer supplying speed cushions in the following specifications should be ISO 9002 approved.

DIMENSIONS

The cushion shall be **modular** in design with standard width being 7.0 ft. (+0.5 ft / -0.5 ft.), and standard length being 6.5 ft. (+0.5 ft / -0.0 ft.) feet. Both width and length shall be adjustable by adding or subtracting modules. The cushion shall have a flat top (optional) with the height being 3 inches (75mm). The entrance and exit ramp gradient shall be a minimum of 1 in 10-15 and the side ramp gradient shall be a minimum 1 in 3.

MATERIAL

The modules shall be made from 100% recycled natural rubber with or without a polyurethane binder. Recycled rubber containing synthetics or other contaminants is NOT acceptable. They shall be compression molded and will have the following properties:

Shore Hardness – 65minimum Specific Gravity - 1.1 to 1.15

The cushion shall be available in either brick red or black. Painting the cushion brick red is **not acceptable**. The standard factory marking (optional) shall be a reflective entrance arrow or other longitudinally mounted reflective strips molded into the rubber for durability. The arrow shall have a minimum size of 2' in width (at the base), and 2' in height (at the apex). The gluing of arrows and retro reflective markings is **not acceptable**. The material shall have a minimum skid resistance of .75 wet, and .90 dry.

INSTALLATION METHOD

The cushion shall incorporate modules of an interlinking design. Each module shall be affixed to the pavement using **stainless steel/anodized** 10mm x 120mm lag bolts and 10mm washers. Substituting plated or galvanized bolts and washers is **NOT** acceptable as they can jeopardize the integrity of the installation. The screws and bolts are inserted into a pre-drilled hole in the pavement that has been filled with a nylon anchor plug. Each hole in the module shall be filled with a rubber plug after installation (optional).

All necessary lag bolts, washers, nylon plugs, resin (if required), and rubber plugs shall be supplied with each cushion.

SPECIFICATIONS

Individual Cushion Modules

Individual modules shall incorporate an interlinking design, and be made available in the following configurations:

- 1. Entrance/Exit Ramp Module shall have an entrance/exit gradient of 1 in 10-15 and shall be 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to 18" in width x 40" to 42" in length x 3" in height.
- 2. Left Corner Ramp Module shall have an entrance/exit gradient of 1 in 10, a side gradient of 1 in 3-4 on the left side of the module, and shall be 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to 18" in width x 40" to 42" in length x 3" in height.
- 3. Right Corner Ramp Module shall have an entrance/exit gradient of 1 to 10, a side gradient of 1 to 3-4 on the right side of the module, and shall be 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to 18" in width x 40" to 42" in length x 3" in height.
- 4. Side Module shall have a side gradient of 1 to 3-4, and shall be 15 ½" to 18" in width x 40" to 42" in length x 3" in height.
- 5. Center Module shall be 15 ½" to 18" in width x 40" to 42" in length x 3" in height. Note: This module has no gradients.

All modules to be supplied with the appropriate reflective marking as specified at the time of order.

WARRANTY

The cushion shall have a 2-year warranty on all components when installed according to manufacturer's directions.

In all construction contracts or subcontracts in excess of \$10,000 to be performed for the City of Chattanooga, any contractor and/or subcontractor is further required to file in duplicate within ten (10) days of being notified that it is the lowest responsible bidder, an affirmative action plan with the EEO Director of the City of Chattanooga. This plan shall state the Contractor's goals for minority and women utilization as a percentage of the work force on this project.
- 5. This Plan or any attachments thereto shall further provide a list of all employees annotated by job function, race, and sex who are expected to be utilized on this project. This plan or attachment thereto shall further describe the methods by which the Contractor or Subcontractor will utilize to make good faith efforts at providing employment opportunities for minorities and women.

During the term of this contract, the Contractor upon request of the City, will make available for inspection by the City of Chattanooga copies of payroll records, personnel documents and similar records or documents that may be used to verify the Contractor's compliance with these Equal Opportunity provisions.

The Contractor will include the portion of the sentence immediately preceding paragraph 1 and the provisions of paragraphs 1 through 6 in every subcontract so that such provisions will be requested of each subcontractor.
