The City of Springfield is requesting sealed bids from sand suppliers for the supply and delivery of bunker sand to The Legacy Golf Course at 100 Ray Floyd Drive, Springfield, TN 37172. The sand will be utilized in the renovation of approximately 11,000 square feet of bunkers using the Better Billy Bunker method of construction.
