Question 6: Does any school have more than 1 plenum where the exhaust fans?

<u>The District's Response</u>: Irmo High does have more than 1 plenum. Vendors are strongly encouraged to verify. Bidders are strongly encouraged to visit the sites prior to bidding to inspect the sites. All visitors are required to check in at the front office of the school.
