## SECTION A INVITATION TO BID

- A-01. Sealed bids from Contractors will be received by the Whitfield County Schools, Dalton, Georgia, Owner, in the Office of the Whitfield County Schools, 1306 South Thornton Avenue, Dalton, Georgia until 1:00 P.M. prevailing time on April 19, 2015 for the construction of the Whitfield County Schools Hvac Modifications, Dalton, Georgia.

The attendance at the pre-bid is mandatory for all bidders who will be submitting bids.
- **A-08.** Contract, if awarded, will be on a lump-sum basis. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after time and date of opening.
- **A-09.** Each bid must be accompanied with a **BID BOND** (Bond only; certified checks or other forms are not acceptable) in an amount equal to 5% of the base bid, payable to the OWNER and issued by a Surety authorized to do business in the State of Georgia, in order to guarantee that the bidder will enter into a contract to construct the project strictly within the terms and conditions stated in this bid and in the bidding and Contract Documents, should the construction contract be awarded to him.
- **A-010.** The successful bidder shall be required to furnish a bond for the faithful performance on the contract and a bond to secure payment of all claims for materials furnished and/or labor performed in performance of the project, both in amounts equal to 100% of the Contract Price. Both bonds shall be issued by a Corporate Surety authorized to do business with the State of Georgia.
