Notice to Contractor:

The following described changes, corrections, clarifications, deletions, additions and approvals for the Contract Documents, which comprise of Addendum No. 1, are hereby made a part of the Contract Documents dated August 4, 2022, and shall govern in the performance of the Work. The contractor shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum.

GENERAL

1. Refer to prebid attendance sheet attached.
2. Refer to attached revised bid form to provide separate pricing for each building.
3. C&C Group is the building controls vendor for the school district.
4. Any supply chain, lead time constraints outside the control of the contractor shall be addressed via negotiation as the issues arise. It is the owners intent to complete this project within the stated dates, however, should that not be possible due to events outside the contractors control a negotiated and mutually aggregable resolution and extension of the project as required will occur.
5. Clarification: Contractor is NOT responsible for any glycol in chilled water systems. Chillers and coils are drained in winters.
6. Delete requirement for new water softeners for water chemical feed systems.
7. Clarification from pre-bid meeting: VFD's are to be replaced for all chilled water and tower water pumps.
8. Replace all exterior conduit to cooling towers and other exterior components.
9. Contractor shall verify existing conductors being reused align with new chiller MCA. Provide new fuses in existing switches in accordance with manufacturers MOCP recommendations. Provide minimum (3)250MCM & (1)#3G in 2-1/2"C. min in accordance with MCA (BOD) and 350A fuses (BOD).
10. At Eisenhower MS, provide a common 10" CTWR header pipe connecting each pump together similar to arrangement at Schlagle.



The undersigned, having familiarized itself with local conditions affecting the cost of the work at the place where the work is to be done and with all Bidding Documents, including the Instructions to Bidders, Plans and Specifications, General and Supplementary Conditions, the Standard Form of Agreement and the other Contract Documents, and having examined the location of the proposed work and considered the availability of labor and materials, hereby proposes and agrees to perform everything required to be performed, and to provide and furnish any and all labor, materials, supervision, necessary tools, equipment, and all utility and transportation service necessary to perform and complete in a workmanlike and timely manner all of the work required for the project, all in strict conformance with the Instructions to Bidders and other Contract Documents (including Addenda Nos. _____, through _____, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), for the lump sums hereinafter specified.

3. TAX EXEMPTION

This project shall be considered Tax Exempt. Federal, State and local taxes shall not be included with the Bid. Subsequent to the award of the construction contract, the School District will obtain from the State of Kansas a sales tax exemption certificate number. The sales tax exemption certificate will permit the Contractor to purchase materials for incorporation into this project without paying sales tax, provided that the Contractor furnishes the certificate number to the material supplier.

4. CHANGES IN THE WORK

Changes in the work shall be as established in the Contract Documents. The following fees shall be used for lump sum pricing and actual cost pricing of additions and deletions to the work included in the Bid, Namely:

	<u>Not to Exceed</u>
A. To Contractor for work performed by his own forces	10%
B. To Contractor for work performed by other than his own forces	5%
C. To Subcontractor for work performed by his own forces	10%
D. To Subcontractor for work performed by other than his own forces	5%

Percentages for overhead and profit will not be allowed on bond premiums.

5. A. In the execution of the Agreement, no person shall on the grounds of race, color, religion, sex, disability, or national origin be excluded from full employment rights, be denied the benefits of, or otherwise subject to discrimination under any program, service or activity under the provisions of any and all applicable Federal and state laws against discrimination. Bidder shall furnish all information and reports required by the rules, regulations, and order of the Secretary of Labor for purposes of investigating to determine compliance with such laws.
- B. Bidder shall observe the provisions of the Kansas Acts Against Discrimination and shall not discriminate against any person in the performance of work under the Agreement because of race, religion, color, sex, physical handicap unrelated to such person's ability to engage in the particular work, national origin or ancestry.
- C. In all solicitations or advertisements for employees, Bidder shall include the phrase, "equal opportunity employer", or similar phrase approved by the Owner.
- D. If bidder fails to comply with the provisions of K.S.A. 441031, bidder shall be deemed to have breached the Agreement and it may be canceled, terminated or suspended in whole or in part, by Owner.
- E. If bidder is found guilty of a violation of the Kansas Acts Against Discrimination under a decision or order of Owner that has become final, bidder shall be deemed to have breached the present Agreement and it may be canceled, terminated, or suspended in whole or in part, by Owner.
- F. Bidder shall include the provisions of paragraphs A through E above in every subcontract or purchase order so that such provisions shall be binding upon all subcontractors and vendors.
8. The undersigned hereby proposes and agrees to substantially and/or finally complete the work or segments of the work on or before the scheduled dates listed in Section 01010-Summary of Work, and to pay as liquidated damages the corresponding amount stipulated in Section 10101-Summary of Work for each consecutive calendar day thereafter that the work or segment of the work remains substantially and/or finally incomplete in accordance with the Contract Documents. This provision shall be applied, and the daily

liquidated damages amount(s) shall be calculated separately as to each substantial and/or final complete date stated.

9. Accompanying the Bid is Bid Security of at least 5% of the bid in the form of a Bid Bond in the amount of ____ Dollars (\$____), payable without condition to the Owner, which it is agreed shall be retained as liquidated damages for the delay and extra expense caused the Owner, if the undersigned fails to execute the Contract and furnish the bonds required by the Contract Documents, within the time stated in the Contract Documents.
10. In submitting the Bid it is understood that the right to reject any and all bids has been reserved by the Owner and that this bid may not be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days from the opening.
