This addendum is hereby incorporated into the Bid/Proposal documents of the project referenced above. The following items are clarifications, corrections, additions, deletions and/or revisions to and shall take precedence over the original documents. Additions are indicated by underlining, deletions are indicated by strikethrough.

- 1. The Opening Date is hereby CHANGED from January 12, 2018 to <u>January 19, 2018.</u>
- 2. Page 17 of 25, Section III, "Scope of Work", Paragraph A, second sentence, s hereby CHANGED to read.

"The Contractor will be responsible for all costs of designing, permitting, installing, maintaining, cleaning, and as applicable, removing he bus benches and bus shelters for 5 years with 2 options to renew the contract for 1 year each. Proposers may suggest alternate contract terms and renewal terms.

3. Page 19 of 25, Section IV, "Advertising Content", Paragraph C.5 is hereby DELETED:

"Advertisements must be for businesses, services, or events located within the city limits of Daytona Beach.

4. Page 23 of 25, Section V, "Design and Construction Requirements", Paragraph D.4 is hereby DELETED:

Benches and shelters will not be located within the City's Community Redevelopment Areas (CRA's), as shown on "RFP 0118-0040 Bus Bench and Bus Shelter Advertising Redevelopment Areas Map", available online at http://purchasing.codb.us under the Public Solicitation link.

5. Answer to Proposer's question, "What is the status of the existing bus shelters within the City limits?

Response: Those shelters will be removed prior to the installation of any benches or shelters by the Contractor.

All other terms and conditions remain the same.

The Bidder/Proposer shall acknowledge receipt of this addendum in their transmittal letter covering their Proposal.
