Project Description: Phase 1

Phase 1 involves demolishing approximately 350 LF of NW Willow Terrace (from NW Palm Street to NW Ashley Street), removing trees and excavating the creek, stabilizing the creek (approximately 300 LF), replacing, reinforcing, and resizing drainage structures, and constructing a ½ Acre Sediment Basin. Items of work include saw cutting and removing concrete roadway leaving a smooth uniform edge, excavation, bank and channel stabilization, dredging a portion of the lake to allow construction, and drainage work.

Phase 2

Phase 2 consist of providing bank and channel stabilization with Gabion mattresses/baskets, regrading approximately 550 LF of the east end of said Tributary B at various slopes.

It is important to note that there is a portion of Tributary B that exist in between these two phases that is not covered under this contract and will be advertised at a later date.
