The City of Goodlettsville plans to enter into a three to five year contract, renewable annually, for sidewalk repair consisting of polyurethane concrete jacking and leveling, soil stabilization and void filling. The City plans to spend up to approximately \$10,000.00 annually for such repairs.

Materials used must meet the following minimum specifications:

Shear Strength, psi	28
Closed Cell Content, %	>90
Water Absorption, lbs/ sq. ft.	<0.08

Resistant to Solvents

Resistance to Mold and Mildew

Bids shall be unit price per square foot of sidewalk repair.

ie. On a typical sidewalk needing repaired at an uneven joint the city would pay based on the square footage of one section being raised (For a 5' sidewalk, approximately 25 sq. ft.).
