Should a conflict occur that is not resolved before bid time, the Bidder shall be responsible for pricing and bidding the more expensive method to comply with mandatory requirements (i.e., codes, ordinances, etc.).

Notes:

1. Quantities are estimated and subject to upward or downward adjustment based on actual field measurements.
2. In computing the volume of excavation, the average end area method will be used.
3. The excavated soil density is assumed to be 72 lbs. /cubic feet.
4. The term "Ton" means a ton equal to 2,000 pounds. Soil material measured by weight shall be weighted on accurate, approved scales at designated landfill locations. Furnish truckload tickets for verification of payment quantities. The tare weight of vehicles hauling the material being paid for by weight is the vehicle's empty weight with the driver aboard.
5. Show unit prices for each line item. Unit prices include the cost of mobilization, general conditions, labor and fringe benefits, excavation, stockpiling, dewatering, equipment, office and field overhead costs, insurance, bonds, local business license, taxes, permits, and profit.
6. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids that appear to be above usual, customary, and reasonable costs for the same scope of Work.
