The BIDDER proposes and agrees that, if he becomes the SUCCESSFUL BIDDER on the basis of this Proposal, he will contract with the **Pierce County Board of Commissioners** (herein called the "OWNER"), in the form of contract illustrated to furnish all necessary equipment, materials, tools, machinery, apparatus, means of transportation, and all necessary labor to complete the construction of the work in full, and in complete accord with the shown, noted, described, specified and reasonably intended requirements of the Specifications, Drawings, and Contract Documents to the full and entire satisfaction of the OWNER, with a definite understanding that no money will be allowed for extra work except as set forth in the General Conditions and other Contract Documents, for the following prices.

NOTE: BIDS shall include sales tax and all other applicable taxes and fees.

The apparent low bid will be determined based meeting all criteria of Item No.19 in the Instruction to Bidders, and then on the sum of the total project and any applicable additive or alternate as chosen by the owner. If the project has no additives or alternates, then the project will be awarded based on the total project bid.

Note: Bidders attention is directed to Section 01150-Measurement and Payment of the Technical Specifications which specify the items for which payment will be made. The Contractor shall distribute (include) all costs associated with the construction of the project into the items listed for which payment will be made.

The above unit prices shall include any and all costs for labor, materials, equipment, bailing, dewatering, sheeting and shoring, demolition, removal, disposal, replacement, overhead, profit, insurance, etc., to cover the finished work of the several kinds called for, complete, in-place and fully operational.

Payment will only be made for the items, listed within the Bid Schedule.

Bidder/Contractors shall include any/all costs for work incidental to a pay item within the applicable pay items. For any/all work for which a specific pay item is not provided, the bidder/contractor shall distribute the costs for such among the items for which payment is allowed. After the Contract is awarded, the Contractor shall only be paid for the pay items listed. Failure of a Bidder/Contractor to include/distribute any/all costs for the complete work within the items listed shall not be considered sufficient reason for additional payment to the Contractor.

The Work shall be performed in accordance with the Construction Drawings and Technical Specifications of these Contract Documents.

Contractor shall verify bid quantities with plan requirements prior to ordering/purchasing materials. Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for any costs or restocking fees for materials purchased and not used due to a discrepancy between bid quantities shown and actual project requirements.

Bidder understands that the owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities in the bidding.

The bidder agrees that this bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of 60 calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receiving bids.

Upon receipt of written notice of the acceptance of this bid, Bidder will execute the formal Contract attached within 10 days and deliver a Surety Bond or Bonds as required by Article 20 of the General Conditions. The bid security attached in the sum of _____ (\$ _____) is to become the property of the Owner in the event the contract and bond are not executed within the time above set forth, as liquidated damages for the delay and additional expense to the Owner caused thereby.
