The above unit prices shall include any and all costs for labor, materials, equipment, bailing, dewatering, sheeting and shoring, demolition, removal, disposal, replacement, overhead, profit, insurance, etc., to cover the finished work of the several kinds called for, complete, in-place and fully operational.

Payment will only be made for the items, listed within the Bid Schedule.

Bidder/Contractors shall include any/all costs for work incidental to a pay item within the applicable pay items. For any/all work for which a specific pay item is not provided, the bidder/contractor shall distribute the costs for such among the items for which payment is allowed. After the Contract is awarded, the Contractor shall only be paid for the pay items listed. Failure of a Bidder/Contractor to include/distribute any/all costs for the complete work within the items listed shall not be considered sufficient reason for additional payment to the Contractor.

The Work shall be performed in accordance with the Construction Drawings and Technical Specifications of these Contract Documents.

Contractor shall verify bid quantities with plan requirements prior to ordering/purchasing materials.

Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for any costs or restocking fees for materials purchased and not used due to a discrepancy between bid quantities shown and actual project requirements.

Bidder understands that the owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities in the bidding.

The bidder agrees that this bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of 60 calendar days

after the scheduled closing time for receiving bids.
