### GENERAL

The City of Waycross will be accepting sealed proposals from contractors for the repair and resurface of 2 tennis courts at Monroe Park, Waycross, GA 31501. Proposals will be accepted until, 11:00 a.m., Thursday, August 15, 2019. Envelope must be sealed and marked Bid # FY20-06.

### **SCOPE**

The City of Waycross is in need of repair of its 2 tennis courts located at the corner of Baltimore Street and Scruggs Street in Waycross, GA. The total measurements of the 2 courts is: 240' x 60'. Both courts are enclosed in a fenced in area with 2 door access. Pictures have been provided for your convenience. This tennis court is on a lighted timer and is accessible 24 hours a day. ### MIMINUM REQUIREMENTS OR AN ACCEPTABLE ALTERNATE:

- Repair 2 center anchors
- Scrape and pressure wash clean the courts surface of all dirt, debris and loose materials
- Machine sand the surface of court as necessary to smooth and repair any uneven or damaged areas such as the raised edges of cracks.
- Patching Using tennis court grade patch compounds:
  - One application will be made to each "birdbath" This will reduce water depth for faster drying times, but may not eliminate all water ponding.
  - o Cover and fill any rough, cracked or deteriorated areas of asphalt.
  - The edges of all patches will be scraped or ground smooth so that patches are not visible through the finished surface.
- Crack Filling Courses Apply one coat of tennis court grade acrylic deep patch mix to the entire surface of the courts with a broad squeegee according to manufacturers recommended coverage rates to fill cracks.
- Leveling Courses—Apply one coat of sand-acrylic resurface mix over the entire surface of the tennis courts with a broad squeegee according to manufacturer's recommended coverage rates.

- Texture and Finish Courses Apply two successive coats of Nova filler coat (sand-filled acrylic color –coating) to the entire area of the tennis courts with a broad squeegee according to the manufacturer's recommended coverage rates.
- Finished colors will be the owner's choice of any two from manufacturer's standard colors.
- Lines Paint two sets of regulation two inch wide white playing lines for the tennis courts.
- Remove all excess materials and debris from the job after completion of the work.
- Warranties must be listed and submitted with proposal.
- If you are quoting other that what is specified above. Details and specification must be included with proposal.
- List 5 references of similar projects that you have completed with location and a name and contact number.
- E-Verify forms must be completed and submitted with your proposal.
- Copy of Insurance Certificate must be included with proposal.
- A Sample Contract has been included in this packet.

Proposals will be evaluated, and an award will be made based on the amount and the type of process used.
