BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Franklin County is seeking bids for a complete purchase and install 4-heating tube systems for a red iron constructed building that is 40'x120' with 14 foot walls. Refer to engineered stamp drawing for specs. (See attached Heater Plan)

There will be a Non Mandatory Pre-bid Meeting/ Site Visit Tuesday February 7, 2023 2:00PM at FCSO, 1 Bruns Dr. Union, Mo 63084.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS/SCOPE OF WORK

- 1. This Contractor shall arrange, schedule, and organize as it pertains to this scope of work all equipment start-ups and Owner Training sessions.
- 2. Construction work shall only be allowed during the following hours: 7AM 4PM (Monday through Friday) Any time outside these hours needs to be pre-approved by the Sheriff and/or a Sheriff appointed staff member to handle this project. A list of county holidays is attached. (See attached list)
- 3. Heating system work shall begin within 30 days of award of bid. If work cannot begin within 30 days, vendor will be required to provide a detailed response of projected timeline to be approved.
- 4. Include cleanup of all rubbish and debris on a daily basis to an area designated by FCSO. Disposal of debris will be at the expense of the vendor.
- 5. All start-up, labor, tools, equipment, materials and supervision to complete the work.
- 6. Coordinate all work with the Sheriff's maintenance director at FCSO, Bill Barns.
- 7. Include cold and hot weather protection as required to maintain the project schedule.
- 8. Contractor will be responsible for sealing all penetrations through walls, ceilings, and floors made during the installation of his own work including Fire Stop and labeling of assembly.
- 9. Contractor to provide adequate equipment for the size of the building to maintain constant temps.
- 10. It is the County expectation that the Contractor will hold appropriate licenses/certifications for trade.

- 11. Contractor to provide a timeline from awarding of the bid to completion of the installation. County understands that the progress of the Steel Building affects this timeline.
- 12. Pre-bid meeting, site visit to the location of the proposed building is non mandatory, but recommended. See dates above.
- 13. See Insurance requirements.
- 14. Alternate pricing for different brands, models, etc. may be submitted within responses to this RFB as long as it meets spec requirements listed on Heater Plan drawing (See attached Heater Plan)

Heating Tube System:

Provide the following or approved equal: Advanced Radiant Systems Model DUH- 125 30ft long tube, with optional side shields, brackets and stainless steel tube. Hang unit as high as possible and level.

Manufacturers standard hanger kit with beam flange clamp and hanging chain. Spaced per manufacturers written instructions.

Provide manufacturers standard horizontal through-wall venting thimble and termination kit. See drawing attached.

4-mounted thermostats to first wall girt. Separate girt with 1X wood blocking

Electrical:

110V duplex out. Mount to beam. Circuit all 4 outlets together. Provide minimum 1/2-inch rigid conduit and #12 75 degree C copper cables/ ground to existing panel. Provide 20 amp breaker in existing panel.

Piping:

All gas line piping will need to be schedule 40

All gas piping will need to be ran from heater to outside regulator location on bldg. at left hand back corner. See drawing for location of shut off valve.

Pipe sizes given on diagram are minimum of inside diameter of pipe. Contractor shall confirm size of pipe with actual volume of fuel each unit will require and pressure available per manufacturers written requirements.

*Vendor will be required to return for start up after regulator and propane tank is installed. This visit and work shall be included in proposed bid. Unknown timeline at the moment as to

when vendor will need to return to complete this process. Weather may be a factor to consider and possibly delay the setting of propane tank.

15. Prevailing Wage

- a.) Not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages, as set out in the wage order attached to and made part of the specification for work under the contract, shall be paid to all workers performing work under the contract. (Section 290.250, RSMo.)
- b.) The contractor will forfeit a penalty to the contracting public body of \$100 per day (or portion of a day) for each worker that is paid less than the prevailing rate for any work done under the contract by the contractor or by any subcontractor. (Section 290.250, RSMo).
- c.) The contractor and all subcontractors to the contract must require all on-site employees to complete the ten-hour construction safety training program required under Section 292.675, RSMo, unless they have previously completed the program and have documentation of having done so.
- d.) The contractor will forfeit a penalty to the contracting public body of \$2500 plus an additional \$100 for each employee employed by the contractor or subcontractor, for each calendar day, or portion thereof, such employee is employed without the required training. (Section 292.675, RSMo).

16. E-Verify

Completion of Affidavit of Work Authorization and provide acceptable documentation of enrollment in the program.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Expectation of the County is that all components integral to the installation are fully functioning and operational upon arrival to the site. Contractor to provide an unconditional guarantee against defect of all workmanship, all equipment, and material for a period of one year from date of acceptance by the County.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The Contractor shall furnish County with a certificate of insurance indicating proof of the following insurance from company's license in the State of Missouri:

 - B. Comprehensive or Commercial General Liability with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, \$3,000,000.00 aggregate combined Single Limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability. This insurance shall include, but not be limited to, the following coverage.
 - 1. Premises Operations
 - 2. Products and Completed Operations
 - 3. Broad Form Property Damage
 - 4. Contractual
 - 5. Personal Injury
 - C. Automobile Liability with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, \$3,000,000.00 aggregate Combined Single Limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability. This insurance shall include coverage for all the following:
 - 1. Owned Automobiles
 - 2. Hired Automobiles
 - Non-Owned Automobiles
 - D. The certificate shall list the Certificate Holder and Address as follows: Franklin County, 400 E Locust Street, Room 206, Union, Mo 63084. The services provided to Franklin County shall be listed under "Description of Operations."
 - E. Such insurance shall include under the General Liability and Automobile Liability policies Franklin County, its employees, elected officials, representatives, and members of its board and/or commissioners as "Additional Insured's".
- 2. The Agreement of Insurance shall provide for notice to the County of amendment or cancellation of insurance policies 30 days before such amendment or cancellation is to take effect.



For all overtime work performed, not less than one and one-half (1½) the prevailing hourly rate of wages for work of a similar character in the locality in which the work is performed or the public works contracting minimum wage, whichever is applicable, shall be paid to all workers employed by or on behalf of any public body engaged in the construction of public works, exclusive of maintenance work or contractual obligation. For purposes of this subdivision, "overtime work" shall include work that exceeds ten hours in one day and work in excess of forty hours in one calendar week; and

A thirty-minute lunch period on each calendar day shall be allowed for each worker on a public works project, provided that such time shall not be considered as time worked.
