Sealed Bids for the project entitled DEE CEE WATER LINE PROJECT will be received by the City of White House at 2 p.m. local time, January 9th, 2017, in the Billy S. Hobbs Municipal Center, 105 College Street, White House, TN 37188, and then publicly opened and read aloud.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at the project site at 10 a.m. December 19th, 2016. Pre-bid questions will be received formally in writing via post or email until COB December 23rd at CSR Engineering, Inc., 1116 Main Street, Pleasant View, TN 37146 (c/o Jason Reynolds) or email at jason.reynolds@csengineers.com. The project generally consists of water main loop connection, valves, hydrants and associated miscellaneous work all within the City ROW and utility easement in the City of White House, TN.

Copies of the Bid Documents may be examined and obtained at CSR Engineering, located at 1116 Main Street, Pleasant View, TN 37146, upon payment of \$100.00 for each printed set. There will be no refund to any party for Bid Documents so obtained. A digital set can be obtained for the same fee and rendered via email. No bids will be received by persons not on the official bid list after obtaining official Bid Documents.

Each Bidder must be appropriately licensed as a Contractor in the State of Tennessee as provided in T.C.A. 62-6-101. The contractor must also be approved as required by the White House Utility District or have documents submitted in accordance with the 4 requirements of the Utility District at the date and time of bid submittal. Any contractor not qualified by the Utility District by the awarding deadline will not be awarded and selection will go to the next lowest bidder.

Attention is called to the fact that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin. Each Bidder shall make positive efforts and are encouraged to use small and minority owned business enterprises on this project.

The City of White House reserves the right to reject any or all qualification statements or accept any presented which meet or exceed these specifications, and/or which would be in the best interest of the City and will not necessarily be bound to accept the lowest proposal.
