Advertisement for Bids

The City of Belle Meade is soliciting **sealed** bids for residential solid waste, trash and recycle collection within the corporate limits of the City. Bids must be received at Belle Meade City Hall, 4705 Harding Road, Nashville, Tennessee *on or before 10:00 a.m. CST on Friday, March 11, 2022*, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. NOTE: Any late, faxed, emailed, or unsealed bids will not be accepted and will be disqualified.

NOTE: In addition to the Bid Form, contractors <u>must</u> submit the following forms:

Failure to include all of these forms will be cause for disqualification.

Related Information

The City of Belle Meade has a population of approximately 3,000 residents, 32 miles of streets and approximately 1,150 homes with the assumption that about one half of households participate in recycling. The City would like to see an increase in participation in the recycle program. The City currently provides once-a-week backdoor solid waste, trash and recycling collection on Mondays and

Tuesdays, and emptying of (3) dumpsters located behind City Hall 3 times per week, on Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Under the existing contract, the homeowners provide their own trash containers, and the City of Belle Meade provides a container for recycle collection. We are requesting each bidder to specify what they will accept as recyclable materials, and how they are to be collected (bagged, what type of bag or loose). In 2020, approximately 1,245 tons of solid waste and trash, and 137 tons of recyclable materials were collected for disposal in Belle Meade.

Scope of Work

The work to be done consists of furnishing all labor, tools, equipment and materials, supplies and services to perform all work and services necessary to satisfactorily collect all residential solid waste garbage, trash, and recyclables from all residences within the City of Belle Meade and City Hall property. Work shall also include transportation of collected solid waste garbage, trash and recyclables to the disposal location, and performance of all other work or services incidental to solid waste garbage and trash and recycle collection and transportation services in strict accordance with the terms and provisions of the final contract and of Belle Meade Code 17-101 et. seq.

Contractor shall schedule two (2) collection days per calendar week for residential pick up, preferably Monday and Tuesday, with no fewer than six (6) calendar days between collections and shall not change such schedule without sixty (60) days' notice and not more than once every six (6) months. The dumpsters behind City Hall are to be emptied three (3) days each week: Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

Homeowners are allowed up to six (6) 32 gallon trash containers OR two (2) 96 gallon wheeled toters OR a combination of the two type containers that does not exceed a total of 192 gallons. There is no limit to the number of recycle containers. The City provides one (1) 32 gallon **recycle** container to residents and they can purchase additional containers from the City if desired. All trash and recycle is picked up "back-door", meaning at the rear of a residence or in another visible area that is accessible from the driveway, but not within an enclosed garage or other building. There is one residential location, at 715 Belle Meade Blvd., that has one (1) 4 cubic yard dumpster that is emptied once a week on the regular trash day. The three dumpsters behind City Hall are located within a wood fence enclosure with lockable gates.

The terms of the final contract shall be for three (3) years as bid, no price increases, with the exception of <u>documented</u> increases to landfill tip fees. The work shall be commenced on July 1, 2022 or at such other time as provided, and shall be completed on June 30, 2025, unless extended or terminated sooner in accordance with the terms of the final contract. The City shall have the option of extending this contract for two (2) additional one (1) year periods. If the City elects to extend, the contractor shall have the opportunity to submit a price increase based on the cost escalator of the lesser of four (4) per cent of the contract or the current Consumer Price Index. The City reserves the right to reject the proposed price increase and solicit bids or proposals for a new contract.

Definitions

Whenever the following terms occur in this document, the interpretation shall have the meaning given as follows:

<u>Bundle</u> – shall mean and include boxes, cartons, paper, and similar material securely bound so as not to exceed five (5) feet in length, six and one-half (6 $\frac{1}{2}$) feet in circumference and weighing less than fifty (50) pounds.

<u>Collection container</u> – shall mean the device the Contractor uses to transport garbage from a standard container to the larger refuse collection vehicles.

<u>Curb</u> – for purposes of this contract, curb shall mean the area within right-of-way limits.

<u>Dumpster</u> – shall be a rear load, eight (8) cubic yard container or other similar container as approved by the City.

<u>Garbage</u> means all waste food associated with common household wastes, or as otherwise defined in Belle Meade Code 17-102 (see Attachment 1 in this bid document)

<u>Plastic bag</u> – shall include a bag made of plastic approximately two (2) feet in diameter and four (4) feet in length and be of sufficient strength to contain the weight of the contents, up to 50 pounds, without breaking open.

Recyclable container – shall mean a 32-gallon covered container, with City logo, provided by the City.

<u>Recyclable materials</u> – All generally accepted recyclable materials, including but not limited to: plastics - numbers (1) and (2), including HPDE milk jugs and PET soda bottles; newspaper; computer paper; aluminum cans; bi-metal and tin cans. No hazardous materials will be acceptable.

<u>Residence</u> – all single family households, condominiums and multifamily dwellings in the City of Belle Meade.

<u>Residential solid waste garbage</u> - solid waste garbage generated at single family households, condominiums and multifamily dwellings, which use containers small enough to be loaded by hand.

<u>Service</u> – shall mean and include the complete removal of stored solid waste garbage and trash from all public and private residences and establishments covered by the Contract, without regard for the degree of fullness of the storage container.

<u>Solid waste garbage and trash</u> – shall include garbage, trash and waste products, recyclables and such other items as are listed in Belle Meade Code, 17-102. (see Attachment 1 in this bid document)

<u>Standard container</u> – for back-door pickup: any watertight metal or plastic container with handles or bails, having a tight-fitting cover and containing a volume of 32 gallons or under, weighing no more than 50 pounds OR wheeled toter up to 96 gallon size. Provided by homeowner.

Billing

The Contractor shall bill the City for monthly services rendered within seven (7) days following the end of the month and the City shall remit payment on or before the 15th day following the end of the month.

Performance Bond

Bidders must include the cost of obtaining a performance bond for this project. The City reserves the right to decide whether or not to require the bond prior to the contract award. See separate line item in the Bid Form.

Insurance

The Contractor must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws including the prevailing wage laws. The Contractor shall procure and maintain for the duration of the contract, at his/her own expense, insurance indicating General Liability of not less than one millions dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence and umbrella liability insurance of up to five million dollars (\$5,000,000) per occurrence to include damages for Bodily Injury, Property Damage, and Personal Injury and Automobile Liability to include owned, hired, and non-owned motor vehicles in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence, with an endorsement naming the City of Belle Meade as additional insured. The Contractor shall furnish to the City a Certificate of Insurance indicating such coverage has been procured and is in force. The Contractor is to also furnish a Certificate of Insurance indicating coverage under a Workman's Compensation Policy that meets the State Minimum Requirements. The Contractor is responsible for work-related injuries of the Contractor's employees and subcontractors. The Contractor must provide all equipment and supervision for this contract and assume responsibility for all uninsured subcontractors. The policies described herein shall be issued by insurance companies that are licensed to conduct business in the State of Tennessee and have a Best Rating of not less than B+. The Contractor must provide a thirty (30) day prior notice of cancellation, non-renewal, or material change in coverage.

Indemnity Requirement

The Contractor further agrees to protect, defend, and save the City of Belle Meade, its elected and appointed officials, agents, employees and volunteers while working in the scope of their duties as such, harmless from and against any and all claims, demands, and causes of action of any kind or character, including the cost of their defense, arising in favor of the Contractor's employees or third parties on account of bodily or personal injuries, death or damage to property arising out of services performed or omissions of services in any way resulting from the act or omissions of the Contractor and /or its agents, employees, subcontractors, representative or the City of Belle Meade under this agreement.

Site Investigation

In the context of the Bid preparation, the Contractor shall be responsible for visiting the site and becoming thoroughly familiar with the content of the bid specifications. Belle Meade staff is available to answer any questions from the contractors. By signing the Bid Form, the contractor certifies that he has investigated and satisfied himself of the site conditions and all components required to fulfill the delivery and execution of the contract work and all other matters which can in any way affect the work under this Contract. Permits and Licenses

The Contractor shall obtain, at his expense, all permits and licenses required by law or ordinance and maintain the same in full force and effect.

Solid Waste Garbage, Trash and Recycling Collection Procedures

All solid waste garbage and trash shall be collected from standard containers (up to six (6) 32 gallon trash containers OR two (2) 96 gallon wheeled toters OR a combination of the two type containers that does not exceed a total of 192 gallons), and from recycle containers, special containers, or special waste receptacles, placed at the back door of residences or at a place designated by the residents that is accessible from the driveway, as long as they are not in an enclosed garage or other building. In

addition, one residential site at 715 Belle Meade Boulevard shall have solid waste garbage collected from one (1) rear load 4 cubic yard dumpster.

All standard containers for waste garbage and trash, as defined in this Contract, will be furnished by the owners of private property. All standard recycling containers will be provided by the City of Belle Meade, with identifying logo.

The Contractor shall be liable for damage by his employees to trash cans, can enclosures, buildings, structures, walls, fences, mailboxes, irrigation equipment, shrubs, hedges, flower beds and grass areas or any other items on private property. All solid waste shall be contained, tied, or enclosed so that leaking, spilling, or blowing is prevented. The Contractor shall promptly clean up any litter that is spilled by Contractor.

The Contractor shall interfere as little as possible with the public use of roads, walks, and entrances to houses, and shall, at his own expense, make such approved temporary provisions as are required to maintain at least one lane of traffic.

The Contractor shall hold and save the City harmless from liability of any nature or kind arising from any use, trespass or damage occasioned by his operation on premises of third persons.

For items requiring special handling due to size, weight, type of material, or method of placements, the charges are to be negotiated between Contractor and resident prior to collection. Rates quoted shall remain consistent with other generally published rates for similar service in the areas.

All complaints shall be resolved within 24 hours. The foreman or superintendent shall check in with City Hall offices twice daily—early morning and again before leaving the City to obtain any messages regarding missed pick-ups or other issues. The City prefers the foreman/superintendent have a mobile phone so he is accessible to the Public Works Director or other City staff during the collection days.

No collection is required for materials placed in cans whose volume exceeds thirty-two (32) gallons OR wheeled toters larger than 96 gallons in volume. Nor is collection required for containers in excess of the limits: six (6) 32-gallon cans, two (2) 96-gallon wheeled toters or a combination of the two types of containers that are less than or equal to 192 gallons. No limitation on number containers shall apply for recyclables.

Materials are considered inaccessible if access is obstructed by a gate that Contractor's staff cannot open and a key code or remote control device has not been provided by the resident; if materials are placed inside an enclosed garage or other structure; or if dangerous/vicious dogs or other animals are not secured.

If materials are not collectable for any reason other than those described in the previous two paragraphs, then Contractor shall leave a written notice on the resident's container identifying such reason and shall also report such reason to the Public Works Director and City Hall offices.

Disposal Operations

All solid waste garbage and trash, upon being removed from the premises where produced or accumulated, shall be transported to or over a public street, alley, lane, right-of-way or place, to legally

designated disposal site. All recyclables collected must be transported in the same manner to an authorized recycling collection center. The City may require verification of this at any time during the contract period. Contractor is responsible for all disposal fees.

Supervision by the Contractor

The Contractor shall personally supervise the work or have a competent foreman or superintendent with authority, satisfactory to the City, to act for it at all times during the progress of the work. The supervisor/foreman shall have a contact phone number that is accessible to the City staff during normal business hours.

Contractor's Personnel

The Contractor shall pay all wages they are required to pay under federal or state law. A qualified person or persons shall be assigned to be in charge of this operation in the City and the contractor shall assign a *permanent dependable crew*. Contractor shall give the names of crew members to the City with information regarding their experience.

The Contractor's collection employees shall wear a clean uniform or shirt bearing the company's name or have a company issued ID on their person. Each driver must carry a valid driver's license for the type of vehicle being driven.

The City may require the dismissal of any employee of the Contractor who violates any provision hereof, or who is wanton, negligent, or discourteous in the performance of his duties. The City may require fingerprinting of collection employees.

The Contractor shall provide operating and safety training for all personnel. No person shall be denied employment by the Contractor for reasons of age, race, sex, creed, religion, or national origin.

Facilities

The Contractor shall maintain an office equipped with telephone and email connections and such attendants as may be necessary to receive and handle complaints or to receive instructions and directions from the City between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding approved holidays.

The Contractor shall provide and maintain radio and/or phone communication with all vehicles used in the performance of this Contract.

Repair of containers

Repairs and maintenance of privately owned standard containers will be the responsibility of the owner unless the damaged condition was caused by the Contractor or any of his subcontractors, in which case the Contractor shall be responsible.

Equipment required of the Contractor

Trucks and other equipment for collecting solid waste garbage, trash and recyclables from standard containers and /or special waste receptacles shall have a tightly closed body to keep to a minimum the nuisance of odors during collection and must be water tight to prevent spillage of wet residue from solid waste garbage and trash from the truck or other equipment body onto the streets, roads, or grounds. Only truck bodies specifically constructed by a recognized manufacturer of this type of specialized

equipment for handling of garbage will be acceptable. Sufficient collection equipment shall be maintained and used by the Contractor to perform service in accordance with established schedules approved by the City. Contractor shall provide a lightweight vehicle for areas where servicing can only be accomplished due to yard size, length of drive, etc., by use of the resident's driveway. All trucks and other mobile equipment used by the Contractor in the performance of services shall be painted a uniform color which provides for good visibility and shall be equipped with rear warning lights, and the name of the Contractor shall be prominently displayed thereon. Contractor shall not use a firm name containing "City" or "Belle Meade" or other words implying municipal ownership.

The Contractor shall maintain all trucks and other equipment in a clean and sanitary condition at all times. Each piece of collection equipment shall be well painted at all times.

The Contractor shall maintain all of his equipment in good working condition at all times. The Contractor shall withdraw from service and promptly repair any piece of equipment which, in the opinion of the City, is unsafe, fails to operate properly or otherwise does not meet other provisions of this contract.

The Contractor shall have available to it at all times, reserve equipment which can be put into service and operation within two (2) hours of any breakdown. Such reserve equipment shall substantially correspond, in size and capability, to the equipment used by the Contractor to perform its duties hereunder.

All solid waste garbage and trash hauled by the Contractor over public streets of the City in open-type containers or vehicles shall be securely tied and covered during hauling so as to prevent leakage, spillage or the release of loose trash. Contractor shall promptly clean up any materials spilled or blown during the course of collection or transportation.

Routes and Schedules

The Contractor shall provide the City with schedules of residential collection routes and keep such information current at all times.

Service shall mean the complete emptying of all containers scheduled for service on the required days and picking up garbage, trash, and recyclables as follows:

- RESIDENTIAL SERVICE Once a week, back door collection, transportation, and disposal of solid
 waste, trash, and recyclables. Once a week residential collection/disposal of trash from one (1) 4yard dumpster at 715 Belle Meade Boulevard.
- DUMPSTERS three (3) rear load, eight (8) cubic yard dumpsters shall be furnished by the
 contractor and placed behind the City Hall, 4705 Harding Road, Nashville, Tennessee and emptied
 three times a week on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday mornings, preferably between 7am and
 8am. Dumpsters shall not be emptied during the overnight hours due to the close proximity to
 residential properties.

Scheduled work shall normally be performed between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. Work at other hours and/or on Saturdays or Sundays will not be required of the Contractor unless he has failed or has been unable to meet the Contract schedule due to unusual or special conditions such as severe ice on the roads, severe flooding, or other extreme conditions. The entire cost of overtime necessary to comply with the schedule shall be paid by the Contractor and shall not be considered a

basis for additional reimbursement. The Contractor shall not begin work prior to 7 a.m. Large trash collection trucks should travel no more than 20 mph on all streets within the City and small pickup trucks should travel no more than 5 mph on residential drives.

Holidays upon which work will not be required are: Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, Independence Day, Memorial Day, and Labor Day. Work schedule shall be moved forward or back one or two days, depending upon what day of the week the holiday occurs, so that every scheduled location receives its regularly scheduled weekly service. Service shall return to the normal work schedule within three days.

Whenever the City notifies the Contractor of locations which have not received scheduled service, the Contractor shall be required to service such locations before 7 p.m. when notified prior to 3 p.m. When notified after 3 p.m. the Contractor shall service such locations no later than 12 noon of the following day including Saturdays.

The City Manager may authorize other collection days and times.

Required Reporting

The City requires Contractor to provide monthly reports no later than the 20th of the following month, detailing the solid waste/trash volume (in tons) and recyclable volume (in tons) collected for the previous month. This can be submitted in any reasonable format, such as email.

Other Services

Contractor shall make available an additional day during the week for waste collection service for residential customers who desire a second weekly pickup day. Contractor is responsible for billing the resident for this service for a price which Contractor determines.

The Contractor is not prohibited from contracting directly with residents to provide services in addition to the services specified herein, *provided that*, Contractor shall not advertise or represent to residents that any additional services are required or recommended by the City without the express permission of the City. Contractor may not charge or attempt to charge residents directly for any services authorized to be provided under the official Contract Agreement.

Severability

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids submitted by prospective contractors. It should be understood that the City reserves the right to terminate the final contract prior to expiration in the event that the successful contractor fails to perform adequately, violates local, state or federal laws in the handling of waste and/or recyclable materials or fails to recycle materials collected under such pretense.

Option to Extend

The Contract may be extended by the City under the same terms and conditions for up to two (2) additional one (1) year periods of time. If the City elects to exercise this right, it shall notify the Contractor of its intent to extend the contract and request information of any price increases based on the cost escalator agreed upon in the original contract. Such notice of extension shall be given in writing to the Contractor at least four (4) months prior to the expiration date of the contract. The City reserves the right to reject the proposed price increase and solicit bids or proposals for a new contract.

ATTACHMENT 1

BELLE MEADE CODE - TITLE 17 - REFUSE AND TRASH DISPOSAL

Section 17-102. Definitions. Refuse and litter shall mean and include garbage, trash, rubbish, mineral and building waste, and dead animals and fowls, but shall not include body waste.

- (1) "Garbage" is defined as putrescible animal and vegetable wastes resulting from the handling, preparation, cooking and consumption of food.
- (2) "Trash" is defined as non-putrescible solid waste, both combustible and noncombustible, including paper, wrappings, cartons and containers of wood, paper, metal, plastic and glass.
- (3) "Rubbish" is defined as tree and hedge trimmings, yard and lawn clippings, leaves, grass, weeds and similar vegetable matter.
- (4) "Mineral and building wastes" shall mean and include ashes, clinkers, scrap concrete, scrap brick, scrap cinder block, scrap masonry stone, scrap glass, scrap metal, scrap roofing, scrap wallboard and scrap lumber from structures or buildings.
- (5) "Dead animals and fowls" refers to those to which death was caused by external injury or disease.
