

**REQUESTS FOR BIDS**  
STATESBORO-BULLOCH COUNTY AIRPORT  
BULLOCH COUNTY, GEORGIA

Sealed bids will be received until Friday, April 23, 2021 at 9:00 AM (EST) at the Bulloch County Commissioners office located at 115 N. Main Street, Statesboro, GA 30458. At said time bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment and performing all work necessary for: Taxiway Rehabilitation at the Statesboro-Bulloch County Airport. Major items of work include: Parallel taxiway mill and overlay, removal of existing taxiway connectors, new asphalt pavement, drainage, marking, and associated electrical.

Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. at the Statesboro-Bulloch County Airport located at 601 Airport Blvd. Statesboro, GA 30461.

Said cost represents the cost of printing, reproduction, handling, and distribution, therefore no refund will be granted. Checks for Bidding Documents shall be payable to “Goodwyn Mills Cawood, LLC” Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a bid guaranty in the amount of five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid. The bid guaranty shall be a bid bond made payable to the Bulloch County Board of Commissioners.

Bids may be held by the Bulloch County Board of Commissioners for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

Award of contract is subject to requirements in the contract documents including, but not limited to, the following Federal provisions:

A Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Goal of 8.88% has been established for this project. The Bulloch County Board of Commissioners, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. §§ 2000d to 2000d-4) and the Regulations, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full and fair opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All contracts and subcontracts that result from this solicitation incorporate by reference the provisions of 29 CFR Part 201, the Federal Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA), with the same force and effect as if given in full text. The FLSA sets minimum wage, overtime pay, recordkeeping, and child labor standards for full and part time workers.

The Contractor has full responsibility to monitor compliance to the referenced statute or regulation. The Contractor must address any claims or disputes that arise from this requirement directly with the U.S. Department of Labor – Wage and Hour Division.

All contracts and subcontracts that result from this solicitation incorporate by reference the requirements of 29 CFR Part 1910 with the same force and effect as if given in full text. Contractor must provide a work environment that is free from recognized hazards that may cause death or serious physical harm to the employee. The Contractor retains full responsibility to monitor its compliance and their subcontractor's compliance with the applicable requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (20 CFR Part 1910). Contractor must address any claims or disputes that pertain to a referenced requirement directly with the U.S. Department of Labor – Occupational Safety and Health Administration.

The Bulloch County Board of Commissioners reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality or irregularity in the bids received.
