RE: Addendum 1 to Jackson County RFP 230016, Road Striping (LMIG), Jackson County

1. Addendum 1 is hereby issued to provide responses to interested vendors/ firms to the below questions submitted to Jackson County.
 - a. **Question:** The proposal does not have any specifications for what materials are to be used. Can you specify which material shall be used for the painted striping (IE. HiBuild or Standard DOT paint) and the stop bars (Paint or Thermoplastic)?
 - i. **Response: Standard DOT Paint**
 - b. **Question:** How is this being paid? The bid form asks for both unit prices and a total for all work. Will this be paid by unit price or as a Lump Sum?
 - i. **Response: Will be paid by unit as work is completed**
 - c. **Question:** How is the striping unit price being measured? Is it being measured by the Linear Mile of a single line (as per GADOT standards) or would a "Mile" include all 4 lines within the mile of roadway?
 - i. **Response: Measured Linear miles, single line**
 - d. **Question:** Existing roads have yellow skips. Will the striping be replaced as currently exists?
 - i. **Response: Stripe as currently exists**
 - e. **Question:** Will all roads receive RPM's?
 - i. **Response: No RPMs**
 - f. **Question:** Will RPM's be installed based on the current specifications (double indicated)?
 - i. **Response: N/A**
 - g. **Question:** The road list shows 4" striping. It appears that the existing striping is the DOT standard of 5". Will 5" be installed?
 - i. **Response: Yes, 5" Installed**
 - h. **Question:** Will the County clip/blade the edges of the roadway, prior to installation of edgelines?
 - i. **Response: County will clip shoulder for striping.**
2. All other terms and conditions in RFQ 230016 remain unchanged.
