The clarifications, modifications, changes, additions, and/or deletions contained herein shall be incorporated within the construction documents for the project. Such information shall take precedence over that previously published.

QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS:

Question: For Weekend Patrols: "Security Officers shall work all weekends from Friday, 9:00 P.M. to Monday, 5:00 A.M., Including all holidays". How many patrols are expected during the daytime on weekends and on Holidays?

(It is understood that Two (2) nightly patrols, Seven (7) days per week, at Twenty-five (25) locations per Exhibit A, at random times, including foot patrols of school campuses and District sites are required.

Clarification: One (1) patrol officer will be expected during the daytime on weekends and on holidays. One (1) patrol officer only for all items on Exhibit "A".

Question: I have a question regarding clarification 1 b.i of Question 1 b.i in Addendum No. 2. It states, "The total hours would be 1 guard x 8 hours a day x 365 days = 2,920 for one year." This is a total of 88 hours per week when you add the 48 hours of coverage needed over the weekend. The clarification states a total of 2,920 hours for one year (which is mathematically accurate), however it should be 4,576 hours per year (88 x 52) for the coverage you are requesting.

Clarification: Yes, you are correct. The total hours per week including the 48 hours per each weekend is 88 hours per week. The correct yearly total for ONE (1) security officer is 4,576 hours per year.

Question: There is an overlap of hours being requested: In 17, You're asking for coverage on Friday from 9P to 5A Saturday Morning. In 18, You're asking for coverage from Friday 9P to Monday 5A. It would seem like 18 should read: Weekend coverage from Saturday at 5A to Monday at 5A.

Clarification: That is correct. Change the item description on page 5 of the Instruction to Bidders and item 18 on Exhibit "A" to "Security Officers shall work all weekends from Saturday, 5:00 A.M. to Monday, 5:00 A.M., including all holidays."

Question: Regarding prior experience: "References for five (5) similar contacts with school districts within the last three (3) years" Our firm has done and provided these services as a Sub Contractor for a prime, and we also have ample experience on these types of services with other locations as well. Would this disqualify us from the bidding process?

Clarification: No, being a subcontractor would not disqualify you from bidding. You are required to have (5) five years of experience minimum,
