- Will black wire be required to have a 9ga steel core before any black coating?
 9 Gauge with black coating.
- 2. Is 2 1/2" end, corner and pull post required to be black? Yes Please reference additional scope information above.
- What diameter line post and gauge of line post is required? (IE. 2" X 8' #40 Pipe with black coating)
 1 1/2 " line post with black coactin. Match current fence on property.
- 4. What diameter and gauge top rail is required? (IE. 1 5/8" #40 pipe with black coating) Please reference additional scope information above. 1 ¼" pipe with black coating
