Notice is hereby given that the CITY OF SHELBYVILLE, TENNESSEE is advertising for sealed bids on:

PAVING OF CITY STREETS - 2015

Bids will be accepted by the City of Shelbyville Purchasing Office, 201 N. Spring St., Shelbyville, TN 37160 or may be mailed to P.O. Box 185, Shelbyville, TN 37162 **until 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 26, 2015**. Any bids received after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids will be returned to the bidder unopened.

The bids shall be opened and read aloud during a public meeting of the City Council appointed Bid Committee on Thursday, March 26, 2015 at 11:00 a.m. at City Hall, 201 N. Spring Street. Award of the bid will be made at the next scheduled City Council meeting at the Shelbyville City Hall Annex. (April 9, 2015)

GENERAL INFORMATION

It will be the sole responsibility of the Bidder to deliver personally or by mail the proposal or proposals to the City of Shelbyville Purchasing Office, 201 N. Spring St., Shelbyville, TN 37160 on or before the closing hour and date announced for the receipt of the bids. **The envelope must be sealed and marked on the outside “SEALED BID FOR PAVING OF CITY STREETS-2015”.**

The City is exempt from taxes imposed by State and/or Federal Government. Exemption certificate, if required, will be furnished by the successful bidder and will be completed by the City.

Each variance to these specifications must be specifically stated by the bidder in the bidding proposal. The City Council reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive informalities and to accept all or any part of any proposal as described therein, as they deem necessary to be in the best interest of the City.

Bidders guarantee that the prices quoted in the bid will remain firm from the date of the bid opening until the completion of delivery.

All proposals shall be made on forms furnished by the CITY. Supporting information shall be on the bidder's stationery.

All proposals must indicate the firm's name and address and be signed in ink by an officer or employee having authority to bind the company or firm.

The intent of these specifications is to insure delivery of a new complete unit for operation. Omission of any essential detail from these specifications does not relieve the supplier from furnishing such unit. All bids must be on new models. This provision excludes surplus, used or demonstrators.

The bidder, by executing a contract or bid proposal on the terms of the invitation to bid, warrants the product that is supplied to be buyer shall remain fully in accord with the specifications and to be of the highest quality. In the event the product, as supplied to the buyer, is found to be defective or does not conform to the specifications, the buyer reserves the right to cancel the order upon written notice to the supplier and return such product to the supplier at the supplier's expense.

Payments will commence or be made in full after delivery and acceptance of product. All documents, invoice, title and exemption certificate shall be presented to the City of Shelbyville Purchasing Office.

All Bidders must comply with A.D.A. guidelines if required.

All Bidders must be in compliance with Title VI, Civil Rights Act of 1964, which specifies that: No person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under a program or activity receiving federal financial assistance from the Department of Transportation or the U.S. Department of Justice.

Failure on the part of the bidder to comply with all instructions herein may result in bid rejection.

All mixes to meet TDOT in-place specifications for all state maintenance work.

Please include in bid package state-approved mix designs for all above mixes.

Please include copy of State of TN permit with bid submission.

PAVING:

1. All bidders are to bid on a per ton basis laid in place anywhere in City limits of Shelbyville. If additional charge is needed for paving of parking lots, drives, etc.- please include additional charge in bid package.
2. Oil content will be 4.5% to 7%.
3. Due to State Maintenance Contract with TDOT, any paving on state routes must be by a TDOT approved vendor for in-place state work. (This portion of our paving is minimal.)
4. Before paving, a grader will grade existing pavement to shave off high spots where needed - provided by successful bidder.
5. Pot holes are to be filled in with hot mix, rolled and compacted before paving of street – provided by successful bidder.
6. The roller shall weigh at least 5 to 8 tons.

7. The paving machine must be equipped with a tamper or vibrator. Systems to be used if the conditions require.
8. The paving or laying of asphalt will be done in accordance with TDOT specifications and will be subject to core test to assure compliance. If the mix design is tested and is found not in compliance, the contract will be void and the vendor will be responsible for the cost of the core test.
9. Thickness of each street will be determined by Shelbyville Public Works Director.
10. All paving loads and thickness are subject to inspection at any time by Shelbyville Public Works Director.
11. Successful bidder must be on-site and ready to pave within a time frame of two weeks after receiving notification from Public Works Director.
12. Any undercutting of street subgrade will be done by Shelbyville City forces.
13. All streets are to be swept, cleaned and edged before paving. This will be the responsibility of the successful bidder.
14. **Due to the volatility in the petroleum industry, this project shall be priced utilizing an asphalt cement**

3. Should milling be performed in areas of existing loop detectors, successful bidder will coordinate sequencing of work to allow re-installation of loop detectors (by others).
4. Milling, trucking and clean-up to be quoted separately on bid form attached.

PAVEMENT MARKING:

1. Striping on an as needed basis as some streets will require striping and some will not. To be determined by Public Works Director. To be

Successful bidder must furnish Certificate of Liability insurance and Workers Compensation insurance to City upon request.

A current business license must also be furnished upon request.
