- Firms must indicate which of the above services they provide and for which they would like to be considered.
- Firms must indicate all applicable ODOT pre-qualifications.
- The qualification package must provide adequate information needed to rank the capability of a firm on each of the categories indicated.
- Please submit **twelve** (12) **copies** of your Statement of Qualifications since this will be distributed to multiple City departments.

- Upon the completion of this evaluation process, the City of Canton will enter into contract negotiations with the firm(s) receiving the highest ranking for each project. At this time, the City will commence fee and contract negotiations with the selected firm most qualified to perform the services as needed. The final scope(s) of engineering services will also be established during these negotiations.
