Isuzu Cab and Chassis

Introduction

The attached specifications describe the requirements for a Replacement Cab and chassis truck and accessories to be purchased by the Chattanooga Public Works Department, Fleet Management division. The specifications are intended to be flexible enough for all major manufacturers to comply. The uses of names or part numbers are used for cross referencing to another brand name to be equivalent or greater to the specifications. Height and weight will be posted in cab in driver's field of view. Any and all wear items will be identified and defined in the bid.

Bid Requirements

1. The entire vehicle/apparatus is to conform to D.O.T., FMVSS, NFPA, and OSHA and to the requirements of all other applicable regulatory agencies.
2. Parts not specifically mentioned that are necessary to furnish a complete chassis or body/apparatus must have been produced using the automotive industries best manufacturing practices. This pertains to design, quality of materials and workmanship.
3. Using the attached specifications, bidders must indicate either "yes" or "no" to the right of all line specifications. Exceptions or "no" responses are to be listed and FULLY Explained on a separate page. Failure to complete the spreadsheet or failure to properly document exceptions to the specifications may result in the bid being declared "non-conforming".
4. Loose and miscellaneous equipment is to be provided only as required by D.O.T and specifications, Fire extinguisher, First aid kit and safety triangles shall be included.
5. Each bid is to be accompanied by a set of manufacturer's and as applicable, vendor's specifications. These are to consist of a detailed description of the proposed vehicle/apparatus and equipment. The specifications are to indicate size, type, model and make of all component parts and equipment. A CAD drawing of the proposed vehicle indicating wheelbase, Cab to axle and Cab to end of frame measurements is desired. All weights and horsepower/torque to transmission ratios to axle ratios shall be approved by engineering per vehicle manufacturer to include all detachable components and operations.

All vehicles will be delivered with factory service manuals, wiring diagrams and component locators for cab, chassis & bodies installed on vehicle. CD's or DVD will be accepted.

All warranties will be listed with specific details as to time, including any and all exclusions. No warranties can be Terminated or canceled for any reason during the warranty coverage as stated in bid where specified. No travel or drive time will be paid while under any manufacturer's warranty.

All power train components, assemblies, subassemblies, component parts and so on, will be designed and constructed with due consideration to the nature and distribution of the load to be sustained and to the general character of the service to which the vehicle is designed for and to be subjected to when placed in service. All parts of the vehicle will be strong enough to withstand the general service under full load. The vehicle will be so designed that the various parts are readily accessible for lubrication, inspection, adjustment and repair. Where ever possible, a central lubrication Block shall be provided with zerks and plumbed to withstand air grease gun applications, this includes hoses and connectors so service personnel will be able to perform this at ground level.

All vehicles will be supplied with a line sheet to include as built and current part numbers of any and all components installed on vehicle.

The specified vehicle will be capable of reaching and maintaining a minimum speed of 20 MPH on any grade up to and including 25% or 15 degree grade. The vehicle will be capable of attaining a true speed of 35 MPH in 25 seconds and programmed not to exceed 62 MPH.

All warranty registrations will be completed by bidder and copies provided upon delivery, all warranties will begin on any and all components on the in service date or delivery date if no special training is needed to begin operating vehicle.

Any special software or hardware needed to perform diagnostics on any computer mounted on cab, chassis and body shall be provided by bidder. This includes Transmission, ABS Brake system and Engine.

1. Warranty period shall be for three (3) years on the Cab and Chassis, bodies and ALL of its components with no exceptions. ____ ____
2. Warranty shall start on in service date. ____ ____
3. All warranty registrations shall be completed by the vendor and copies provided. ____ ____
4. Factory service manuals, electrical schematics and component locators to be supplied for body, Cab and chassis. ____ ____
5. Bid an optional Warranty period to be “bumper to bumper” and defined by the bidder, for five (5) years on the body, chassis, engine, transmission and drivetrain, excluding wear items, which must be detailed, with no provision for canceling warranties. ____ ____
6. Ten (10) workday repair completion guarantee. The primary vendor will pay the lease cost per day of each day after the tenth day turnaround period has elapsed. Partial days will be prorated based upon an eight (8) hour work day, beginning at 8:00 am. ____ ____
7. Instead of the lease cost per day Ten (10) work day repair completion guarantee penalty, the vendor can provide a loaner vehicle of equal to or better quality specifications of the rear load garbage truck that has exceeded the ten day repair limit. ____ ____
8. Bidder shall include copy of warranty terms and conditions and a list of any exceptions from the warranty. ____ ____
9. All warranty work for cab, chassis, and body shall be the responsibility of the Primary bidder. ____ ____

1. Minimum of 2-hour professional training for operators. ____ ____
2. Minimum of 2 day training to be available to on site shop personnel.

The Contractor will include the portion of the sentence immediately preceding paragraph 1 and the provisions of paragraphs 1 through 6 in every subcontract so that such provisions will be requested of each subcontractor. The Contractor agrees to notify the City of Chattanooga of any subcontractor who refuses or fails to comply with these equal opportunity provisions. Any failure or refusal to comply with these provisions the Contractor and/or Subcontractor shall be a breach of this contract.
