It will be the sole responsibility of the Bidder to deliver personally or by mail the bid or bids to the City of Shelbyville Purchasing Office, 201 N. The envelope must be sealed and marked on the outside "Sealed Bid for Boiler Replacement at Shelbyville Recreation Center".

The City is exempt from taxes imposed by State and/or Federal Government. Exemption certificate, if required, will be furnished by the successful bidder and will be completed by the City.

Each variance to these specifications must be specifically stated by the bidder in the bidding proposal. The City Council reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive informalities and to accept all or any part of any proposal as described therein, as they deem necessary to be in the best interest of the City.
