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I. INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

1. GENERAL

Potential offerors interested in providing Construction Manager at Risk Services ("CMAR") for the Arlington Transit ("ART") Operations and Maintenance Facility ("AOMF") in Arlington, Virginia must first apply to be prequalified. This Request for Qualifications is the first phase of a two-phase procurement process. The County will evaluate applications based upon the identified evaluation criteria and will select those Applicants it deems qualified. Only those Applicants deemed qualified will be invited to submit a proposal in response to a detailed Request for Proposals ("RFP"), which will be issued in the second phase of the procurement process.

The County is not responsible for any costs that Applicants incur in this procurement process.

All materials submitted by Applicants become the property of the County and will not be returned.

The County reserves the right to modify, suspend, or cancel this procurement at any time in its sole discretion.

2. QUESTIONS AND ADDENDA

OFFERORS MUST BE REGISTERED IN VENDOR REGISTRY TO SUBMIT A QUESTION FOR THIS REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS.

All communications relating to this solicitation must be submitted online using Vendor Registry. For a question to be considered, the question must be entered in the Question Section of the RFQ No. 20-030-RFQ. Vendors must be registered to respond and/or submit questions to this RFQ. Prior to the award of a contract resulting from this solicitation, Applicants and prospective Applicants are prohibited from contacting any County staff other than those assigned to the Office of the Purchasing Agent.

3. COMPETITIVE NEGOTIATION FOR NON-PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

This solicitation is a Request for Qualification for acquisition of construction on a fixed price or not-to-exceed price construction management basis, as defined in the Arlington County Purchasing Resolution.

4. VIRGINIA CONTRACTOR LICENSE

For all work that is classified as being performed by "Contractors" as defined by the Virginia State Board for Contractors, a Class A, B, or C License is required. The Offeror awarded the contract resulting from this solicitation is required under Title 54.1, Chapter 11, Code of Virginia, as amended, to be licensed as a "CLASS A CONTRACTOR."

5. NOTICE REQUIRED OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES IN BONDING STATUS

If an Applicant experiences a material change in its bonding status or corporate structure after applying for prequalification and before the award of the contract for the Project, if applicable, the Applicant must notify the County of the change in writing within five business days. If the Applicant fails to do so, the County may rescind the Applicant's prequalification or reject the Applicant's proposal.

6. AUTHORITY TO TRANSACT BUSINESS

Any Applicant organized as a stock or nonstock corporation, limited liability company, business trust, or limited partnership or registered as a registered limited liability partnership must be authorized to transact business in the Commonwealth of Virginia as a domestic or foreign business entity if so required by Title 13.1 or Title 50 of the Code of Virginia, or as otherwise required by law. The proper and full legal name of the entity and the identification number issued to the Applicant by the Virginia State Corporation Commission must be included on the Proposal Form. Any Applicant that is not required to be authorized to transact business in the Commonwealth must include in its proposal a statement describing why the Applicant is not required to be so authorized. The County may require an Applicant to provide documentation that 1) clearly identifies the complete name and legal form of the entity and 2) establishes that the entity is authorized by the State Corporation Commission to transact business in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Failure of an Applicant to provide such documentation will be a ground for rejection of the proposal or cancellation of any award. 7. NOTICE OF PREQUALIFICATION DECISION

When the County has made a decision in regard to prequalifying the Applicants, the County will post a Notice of Prequalification Decision to Vendor Registry.

II. SCOPE OF WORK

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The intent of this solicitation is to prequalify Contractor(s) who will then be eligible to submit proposals to provide preconstruction and construction management services in connection with the razing of the existing building and structures and construction of ART Operation and Maintenance Facility (AOMF) on two parcels of land with extensive site work and coordination. The proposed new AOMF will be located at 2629 and 2635 Shirlington Road, Arlington, VA.

The County will engage a designer (the "Architect") to develop a design for the AOMF. In general, the Construction Manager selected through this process will be required to work with the Department of Environmental Services ("DES") Facilities Design & Construction Bureau ("FD&C"), DES Transit Bureau ("Transit"), ART Operator ("Operator") and the Architect to:

- i. Advance the design for the Project in a manner consistent with the Project budget, the schedule, and the programmatic and other requirements for the Project;
- ii. Develop a Guaranteed Maximum Price ("GMP") proposal based on the GMP/Permit Set prepared by the Architect; and
- iii. Upon acceptance by the County of any GMP Proposal, the Contractor shall demolish the existing building and structures and construct the new AOMF based on the approved design, including performing all hazardous materials abatement and selective and bulk demolition necessary.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Construction Manager (CM) shall provide all expertise, labor and resources for complete preconstruction and construction management services associated with the construction of AOMF located at 2629 and 2635 Shirlington Road, Arlington, VA (the "Project").

During the design phase, the CM shall provide cost estimates and cost evaluation, value engineering recommendations, design analysis, constructability reviews and technical input on methods of construction materials and details. The design phase is anticipated to commence when design plans reach the 40% stage approximately in the third quarter of 2020.

The construction phase will commence after all necessary permits are obtained in the first quarter of 2022 and is anticipated to last approximately 16 months.

The CM shall assume responsibility for project construction cost by issuing a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) not later than 90% through the design phase of the project and at approximately completion of the first building permit plan review stage. The GMP will be a contractual obligation. In addition, the Contractor shall be responsible for methods of construction, safety and the scheduling and coordination of the work of all construction and miscellaneous contracts required for completion of the project within its predetermined budget and schedule.

The new AOMF will include site development, Operation /Dispatch and Administration facility and Maintenance facility. The County requires the Project to be designed to attain minimum LEED Silver status.

- Site Development:
 - O Stream Channel and Shirlington Rd crossing improvements

- Demolishing of the existing building and concrete pad
- Surface parking for 68 ART buses,
- Structured parking for 110 personal vehicles
- Yard/green areas
- Site drainage and SWM
- Covered storage space
- Operation/dispatch and Administration Facility:
 - Transit Operation/Dispatch
 - Transit Administration
 - Bus Operator support areas
 - Building support areas
- Maintenance facility to perform maintenance for a fleet of 110 buses:
 - Maintenance administration
 - O Seven Repair and one chassis wash bay for 40 ft. buses
 - Shop Equipment
 - Parts Storage
 - Maintenance personal support areas

The existing site ("Site") includes three parcels of land as shown on the attached plan (Attachment J):

- Parcel A (2.53 Acres) With an existing concrete pad
- Parcel B (0.94 Acres) With an existing building
- Parcel C (0.05 Acres) Vacant

The Project will include razing of one (1) existing building and a concrete pad. The existing building located at 2635 Shirlington Rd. (Parcel B) will be removed and replaced with the new ART operation center and private vehicle parking structure. In addition, a concrete pad located at 2629 Shirlington Rd. (Parcel A) will also be razed.

Parcel A currently serves as ART's existing bus parking and dispatch facility. The County's intent is to relocate the buses to another temporary facility during construction. However, the County may decide, during the design of the facilities and prior to the establishment of the GMP, to phase the project to provide parking at the Site for all or some of the existing bus fleet.

The budget for hard costs, Construction Manager fees and general conditions is \$45 million (the "Project Budget").

III. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. GENERAL

Applications must be submitted fully executed. FAILURE TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION WITH A FULLY COMPLETED APPLICATION FORM USING THE APPLICATION FORM PROVIDED IN THIS SOLICITATION WILL BE CAUSE FOR REJECTION OF THE APPLICATION. A person legally authorized to bind the Applicant must sign the Application Form.

The County will not accept applications by fax or e-mail.

The Application must address the elements listed below, in the order listed, and must not exceed the page limitation of 20 pages excluding the Attachments. The Application must be, single-spaced, and the type size must not be less than 10-point.

Applications and all documents related to this solicitation become the property of the County upon receipt.

2. APPLICATION FORM SUBMISSION

The submitted Application Form must be signed and marked "ORIGINAL". The Application Form must be submitted electronically via Vendor Registry no later than the date and time deadline specified in this solicitation. The Vendor Registry System will not accept responses after the close date and time.

The Contractor/Vendor name on the electronic application submittal shall be the same as the Contractor/Vendor name as the registration in Vendor Registry for the submittal to be considered a valid response. ONLY ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION IS ALLOWED, NO APPLICATION SUBMITTED OTHER THAN A VENDOR REGISTRY ELECTRONIC SUBMITTAL WILL BE ACCEPTED. Arlington County is not responsible for late submissions, missed Addenda, or questions not submitted before the end date and time.

Timely submission of the application is the responsibility of the Applicant. The Vendor Registry System will not accept Applications after the publicly posted date and time. An application may be rejected if the Application Form is not signed in the designated space by a person authorized to legally bind the Offeror.

The County may reject any Application that modifies or supplements the solicitation requirements.

3. <u>APPLICATION STANDARDS</u>

Applications submitted in response to this solicitation should be accurate and grammatically correct and should not contain spelling errors.

4. UNNECESSARILY ELABORATE RESPONSES

The County may view unnecessarily elaborate brochures or other presentations, including elaborate or expensive artwork, paper, bindings, and visual and other presentations, as an indication of the Applicant's lack of cost consciousness.

5. EVALUATION CRITERIA

The County will be evaluating applications for compliance with items I. through VIII. under Prequalification Application Submittal Elements below. Only applications that comply with all requirements will be deemed prequalified.

PREQUALIFICATION APPLICATION SUBMITTAL ELEMENTS:

- I. QUALIFICATION APPLICATION FORMS: Applicants must submit Attachments A and B.
- **II. SURETY STATEMENT:** The Applicant must have sufficient financial ability to perform the contract that will result from this procurement.

The Applicant must provide, on a Surety's letterhead, a signed Surety Statement that indicates that the Surety knows of no reason why the Surety could not provide bid, performance and payment bonds in the amount of 100% of the Project Cost for the Applicant in connection with the Project. The letter must also state that the Surety has certificates of authority as an acceptable surety authorized to do business in the Commonwealth of Virginia, as published annually in the Federal Register, Department of Treasurer, Fiscal Service, Department Circular 570. The Surety may use Attachment C as a quide.

III. PROJECT SPECIFIC QUALIFICATIONS:

Unless specified otherwise, all projects listed as qualifying experience for items must have been performed by the Applicant to qualify. The Applicant must submit all referenced projects using form of Attachment D. The Applicant must use a separate form for each project listed and may also attach supplemental information on the projects. Use form included as Attachment E as a cover sheet for the reference projects to indicate which projects are used to qualify under specific experience requirements.

1. DEMONSTRATED PROJECT EXPERIENCE OF THE COMPANY:

Provide a project work description for at least five (5) projects that the Applicant has completed as the general contractor within the past ten (10) years from the date of issuance of this RFQ, that is similar in scope and size to the ART Operations and Maintenance Facilities described in this RFQ. These similar or qualifying projects must include all of the following elements:

- i. construction value that is the same or greater as the County's proposed project,
- ii. at least two (2) projects must have been delivered through the construction management at risk delivery method for a public entity.

The five (5) projects should be for distinct and separate clients. Projects should have been performed for a public transit system with secondary (Type II) maintenance facility. Clients (including owners, designers and/or construction managers) will be contacted to confirm the Applicant's performance, workmanship, quality, and ability to meet the scheduled completion dates, as the general contractor. All reference clients' phone numbers and email addresses must be valid. Any reference which include invalid phone numbers or email addresses may be considered as non-responsive.

The County will ask the Applicant for records demonstrating its construction safety performance with an Experience Modification Record (EMR) of 1.0 or less for three most recent available consecutive calendars years, no earlier than 2013, if shortlisted during the evaluation process.

2. LEED PROJECT EXPERIENCE:

PROJECT/CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM EXPERIENCE: Provide at least two (2) projects of similar size that demonstrates the Applicant's experience in utilizing a web-based project management system for the electronic distribution of project documents, submittals, Change Proposals, RFIs correspondence etc. The Applicant must describe the web-based Project/Construction Management Software used.

IV. STATEMENT REGARDING JUDGMENTS: The Applicant or any officer, director, or owner thereof must not have had judgments entered against him within the past ten years from the date of issuance of this solicitation for the breach of contracts for governmental or nongovernmental construction, including, but not limited to, design build or construction management.

The Applicant shall include a certification to that effect, or provide a detailed explanation on a separate sheet, if necessary.

V. STATEMENT REGARDING COMPLIANCE: The Applicant must not have been in substantial noncompliance (without good cause) with the terms and conditions of prior construction contracts with the County, or, if the County has not contracted with the Applicant in any prior construction contracts, of comparable construction contracts with another public body.

The Applicant shall include a certification to that effect, or provide a detailed explanation on a separate sheet, if necessary.

VI. STATEMENT REGARDING CONVICTIONS: The Applicant or any owner, officer, director, owner, project manager, procurement manager or chief financial official thereof must not have been convicted within the past ten years from the date of issuance of this solicitation of a crime related to governmental or nongovernmental construction or contracting, including, but not limited to, a violation of Article 9 of the Arlington County Purchasing Resolution, the Virginia Governmental Frauds Act (§ 18.2-498 et seq.), Chapter 4.2 (§ 59.1-68.6 et seq.) of Title 59.1, or any substantially similar law of the United States or another state.

The Applicant shall include a certification to that effect, or provide a detailed explanation on a separate sheet, if necessary.

VII. STATEMENT REGARDING DEBARMENT: The Applicant or any officer, director or owner thereof may not currently be debarred pursuant to an established debarment procedure from bidding or contracting by any public body, agency of another state or agency of the federal government.

The Applicant shall include a certification to that effect, or provide a detailed explanation

on a separate sheet, if necessary.

VIII. VIRGINIA CONTRACTOR LICENSE: The Applicant shall provide a copy of its current Class A Virginia Contractor's License.
