### ADDENDUM I Answers to Questions

1. *Section 10.0 Body Specifications: The top of the body is to be 12-gauge smooth plate, which shall be the actual top of the body. Top has greater rigidity with integral drip rail formed into plate top.*
  - a. Can you please offer additional explanation for the area referred to as “top of the body?” Is this referencing the body compartment tops?  
**Yes, this does refer to the compartment tops.**
  
2. *Section 10.0 Body Specifications: Shelf clips on all vertical compartments.*
  - a. Can you please explain what is meant mean by shelf clips?  
**The walls of the storage compartments should include a system which allows for vertical adjustment/repositioning of shelves within the compartment.**
  
3. *Section 19.0 Chassis: 6-Speed Automatic Transmission w/PTO Provision.*
  - a. 2020 Ford Chassis now come with 10-speed Automatic Transmissions instead of 6-speed. Can this be updated since a 6-speed is no longer a manufacturer option?  
**Yes, 10 speed automatic transmission is correct.**
  
4. *Section 18.0 Additional Equipment (To be included): Two 6” PVC Tubes (etc).*
  - a. Can a preferred location for these PVC tubes be specified?  
**Two (2) – 6” PVC tubes should be mounted side by side on the top of the curb-side body compartment. These tubes should be 108” long and should have lockable end caps at the rear of the truck.**
