Selected Contractors are invited to bid on the "Hanahan Downtown Streetscape Project." The project is located Yeamans Hall Road from Remount Road to Sledge Street, in the City of Hanahan, Berkeley County, South Carolina and is owned by South Carolina Department of Transportation and being developed by the City of Hanahan.

Work will include but will not necessarily be limited to:

- Construction of 0.4 miles of streetscape improvements.
- Improvements shall include, but will not necessarily be limited to, sidewalks, low seat wall, landscape, site lighting, drainage improvements, utility improvements, curb and gutter and paving improvements associated with the new construction.

A Bid Security, in the form of a surety bid bond and in the amount of 5% of the Total Bid will be required to be included with your Bid.

The selected Bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, in the amount of 100% of the Total Bid, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. The cost of the Bond shall be included in the Base Bid.

Bidder agrees that he may not withdraw or modify his proposal for a period of sixty calendar days after the scheduled bid opening.

The successful Bidder will be required to obtain all applicable licenses and to comply with all applicable laws, ordinances and codes. Certification of Insurance and Worker's Compensation Coverage will be required.
