at which time and place the proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud. Proposals received after the designated time will not be considered. The OWNER of the project is the CITY OF GRIFFIN. The ENGINEER for the project is FALCON DESIGN. The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER for the project is PARAGON CONSULTING GROUP.

The approximate extent and character of the Work is generally described as follows:

The project consists of street and drainage improvements along portions of Hill Street, Solomon Street and South 5th Street in downtown Griffin, Georgia. The work includes areas of new curb and gutter, asphalt overlay, parking and travel lane striping, handicap ramps, crosswalk improvements, and new storm drainage.

Bidding Documents/Project Manual must be obtained by prospective Bidders from the Issuing Office: Paragon Consulting Group, Inc., 118 North Expressway, Griffin, Georgia 30223, 770-412-7700.

Any Contractor submitting a bid must be licensed by the State of Georgia and must be a pre-qualified Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) Contractor. In order to obtain a complete set of Bidding Documents/Project Manual and be on record as an Official Bidder, Prospective Bidder shall provide a copy of current Utility Contractor License and a GDOT Pre-Qualification number together with non-refundable payment of \$350.00. Bidder shall also provide a letter from its Surety Company verifying the Bidder has the bonding capacity as outlined for the project and that the Surety Company will bond projects for Contractor as outlined in the specifications. The OWNER is not obligated to consider a Bidder's proposal if Bidder is not on record with the Issuing Office as having received complete Bidding Documents/Project Manual from the Issuing Office.

A *pre-bid conference* will be held on **Tuesday, January 8, 2019** at the City of Griffin, 100 S. Hill Street, Griffin, Georgia, at 10:00 a.m. local time in the 3rd Floor Conference Room. Attendance is not mandatory but all interested contractors are strongly encouraged to attend.

The time allowed for Substantial Completion is 330 days, and the time allowed for completion and readiness for final payment is 360 days from the date of commencement.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond completed on the provided Bid Bond Form with good and sufficient surety or sureties approved by the owner for faithful acceptance of the contract, payable to, in favor of, and for the protection of the OWNER in an amount equivalent to five (5%) of the total amount payable by the terms of the contract, in lieu thereof, in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or cash in equal amount.

Performance and Payment Bonds, each in an amount at least equal to **110** percent of the contract amount, and a Certification of Insurance will be required.

All Bids will remain subject to acceptance for ninety days after the day of the Bid opening, but OWNER may, in its sole discretion, release any Bid and return the Bid security prior to that date.
