#### Issue Date: November 2, 2022

The Board of County Commissioners of Curry County, State of New Mexico, has issued the following Addendum #1 to the Request for Proposal for Detainee Medical Services No. 2022/23-02.

This Addendum is issued to reflect the following changes and address the following questions:

<u>**Question 1**</u> – Per RFP page 16, it is indicated the mental health team is to provide detainee NARCAN education. Would it be amenable to the County that this service is provided by the medical health team?

<u>Answer –</u> Yes.

**Question 2 -** On RFP page 24, Alternate Components will the County please provide estimated quantities for items 1-5?

<u>Answer</u> –. Questions 1-5 regarding Staffing for Detention Center is 77.5 persons, and the Detainee population when completely full is 262 individuals. Under emergency planning please plan for the 262 detainees.

<u>**Question 3**</u> – Per RFP page 24, a Quality Assurance Employee is requested under Alternate Components. Please provide a description of duties for this position.?

<u>Answer</u> – Please refer to your Compliance & Accreditation representative for guidance and feedback regarding the Quality Assurance duties. The purpose of the Curry County Medical Quality Assurance (MQA) program is to effectively and efficiently regulate health care professionals to ensure that all mandatory medical standards are within compliance which will aid in protecting the health and safety of all detainees that are under the direct supervision of a medical provider. This position will be responsible and accountable for the compliance of all 44 medical mandatory standards through a comprehensive medical internal audit system.

<u>**Question 4**</u> – Please confirm the bidding Average Daily Population (ADP).

Answer – Based on July 2021-July 2022, during Covid 155 ADP and Pre-Covid 175 ADP.

**<u>Question 5</u>**--How are medications being dispensed by the current vendors? Can we get their schedule for medication dispensing for a 24-hour period?

<u>Answer--</u>Med Pass is conducted with a security officer and a nurse in front of the pod areas and or cell side in our restrictive housing areas. Med Pass- 0700 and 1900.

**Question 6--**What is the start and end of shift hours for the nursing staff (day/evening/night shifts)?

Answer-- Shift hours 0600 to 1830.

**Question 7--**Can we get the medical schedule of the current month and next month's schedule?

<u>Answer--</u>2 Nurses on Day Shift, 1 Nurse and EMT in the evening shift.

<u>**Question 8--**</u>Can we get a list of the medical staff positions (titles, not names of a staff member – for medical & mental health) that are currently filled, or position names not filled?

<u>Answer--</u>We have 2 vacant Nurse Positions at this time.
