

### **INVITATION TO BID**

Pursuant to North Carolina General Statutes §143-131, the City of Havelock invites informal bids on the following:

Wells Wayside Pump Station Relocation

Bids must be submitted in accordance with the attached specifications.

Bids can be submitted by mail, email, fax or hand delivered. Cover sheets, envelopes, etc. should be clearly marked with the words:

Bids will be accepted until **3:00 p.m. (EST) on <u>June 9, 2017</u>** at which time they will be reviewed in the office of the City Finance Director. Quotes are not subject to public inspection until the contract is awarded. The bids are good for 75 days after opening.

Bidders are cautioned not to submit bids until the proposed requirements and specifications have been carefully examined. It will be considered that bidders will have satisfied themselves as to the accuracy of the specifications. No proposal will be considered unless prices are submitted for all items requested in any section. The City reserves the right to change the amount of quantities. Any addenda will be posted on the City website. It is the responsibility of the contractor to check the City website for addenda.

The names of certain brands or makes denote quality standard in the article desired, but do not restrict bidders to the specific brand, make or manufacturer named. They are meant to convey to prospective bidders the general style, type, character and quality of the article desired.

The successful bidder on all construction contracts will be required to conduct the operation in accordance with all Federal, State, and Municipal health and safety rules, regulations and laws applicable to the operation. The successful bidder may be asked to provide the City with a copy of the company's safety plan prior to commencing work. For all projects over \$30,000, a general contractor's license must be furnished to the City if applicable.



North Carolina General Statutes, specifically §160A-20.1(b), prohibit the City from entering into contracts with contractors and subcontractors who have not complied with the requirement of Article 2 of Chapter 64. The Contractor shall submit the E-Verify Affidavit, located in the Bid Proposal section, with their bid. Bids that do not include this Affidavit will be considered non-responsive.

N.C.G.S 147-86.55-69 requires certification for bids with a North Carolina Local Government. The certification is required at the time when a bid is submitted. N.C.G.S 147-86.55-69 requires that contractors with a North Carolina Local Government must <u>not</u> utilize any subcontractor found on the State Treasurer's Final Divestment List. The State Treasurer's Final Divestment List can be found on the State Treasurer's website at the address <u>www.nctreasurers.com/Iran</u> and will be updated every 180 days.

The City of Havelock reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to purchase items from the state contract in the efforts to award the contract to the bidder it deems to be for the best interest of the City.

## Havelock NC Wells Wayside Pump Station Relocation Scope of Work

### 1. Summary of Work

- A. Relocation of an existing submersible pump station that serves one building near the intersection of Pine Grove Rd. and US Hwy. 70 in Havelock North Carolina. The existing pump station is located within the NCDOT right of way and shall be relocated approximately 25 feet north outside of the right of way.
- B. Work includes installation of a new fiberglass wetwell, relocation of existing pumps and power components, reconnection of the service line from the building, and reconnection of the discharge line to the existing force main.

### 2. Schedule

A. The work shall be completed and the area fully restored prior to August 1, 2017.

### 3. Coordination

- A. Work shall be coordinated with the property owner to minimize interruption to service.
- B. Access to the existing property driveways shall not be blocked.

### 4. Permitting

- A. Contractor shall be responsible for obtaining required building permits and coordinating all required inspections.
- B. The power for the pump station is provided by the City of New Bern. Contractor shall be responsible for coordination power disconnection and reconnection with the City of New Bern. The existing power meter number is 55056.

#### 5. General Construction Sequence

- A. Obtain all required permits.
- B. Install new 2ft x 8ft fiberglass wetwell as manufactured by Myers or equal. Wetwell shall be compatible with existing pumps. Wetwell shall have a flare ring at the bottom. Install 2 CY of concrete around the flare ring.
- C. Relocate existing 8ft wide treated wood panel, controls, and underground power.
- D. Relocate existing 2 HP single phase 230/208 volt Meyers Grinder pumps to new wetwell. Guide rails, floats, and all other equipment in the existing wetwell shall be turned over to the Owner.
- E. Reconnect existing 4" PVC service lateral to the new wetwell. The existing service lateral is approximately 4 feet deep.

- F. Reconnect 1.5" schedule 40 PVC discharge pipe to the relocated pumps and to the existing force main. The existing force main is approximately 3 feet deep.
- G. Install six pipe bollards to match existing in similar locations around the relocated pump station.
- H. To abandon the existing wetwell, remove and dispose of the top 3 feet of the wetwell. Fill the remaining wetwell with compacted select fill. Compact area backfilled.
- I. Compact all disturbed areas and seed per NCDOT right of way standards.
