INSTRUCTIONS FOR BIDDERS

Invitation for Bids:

Copies of the Bid Specifications will be available at 10 am CST, Thursday, January 24, 2019 at Belle Meade City Hall, 4705 Harding Road, Nashville, TN 37205, or on the City website, www.citybellemeade.org, under "Doing Business with the City". For questions or information, please contact Public Works Director Larry Smith, at 615-297-6041 or email at lsmith@citybellemeade.org.

Bids are being solicited only from responsible and established bidders who are experienced and regularly engaged in this work. References are required and satisfactory evidence that the bidder has the necessary capital, equipment and personnel to do the work may be required.

Bidders are encouraged to examine buildings and conditions and schedule a walk-through with the City's representative to verify finishes, locations, room dimensions, etc., and identify any areas of concern or uncertainty.

Separate sealed bids will be received by the City of Belle Meade online or at 4705 Harding Road, Nashville, TN 37205 until 1:00 PM, CST, on Wednesday, February 13, 2019 for:

- Prepping and painting of interior walls, trim and doors, and some ceiling areas in City Hall and Public Works Garage.
- Prepping and painting all exterior wood trim and doors on both buildings, as specified.
- Pressure washing, cleaning aluminum gutters on both buildings, and caulking and sealing as needed.

Bids will subsequently be publicly opened and read aloud. The City reserves the right to waive informalities and to reject any and all bids, in part or in their entirety.

Description of Work and Bidder Information:

The successful bidder shall complete the following work. Include all labor, materials and equipment for cleaning, prepping, painting and finishing as described herein. Interior paint finishes are eggshell for walls, flat for ceilings, and satin for doors and trim. Paint samples for each color shall be submitted for approval before starting project.

- 1. Exterior of City Hall and Public Works Garage
 - Pressure wash
 - Clean aluminum gutters
 - Caulk and seal where needed
 - Repaint wood surfaces, doors and trim with 2 coats of exterior latex based paint as specified

2. Interior of City Hall and Public Works Garage – Clean, prep and paint all exposed drywall, trim and doors as described below and in Appendix A. Repair/patch all cracks and holes in drywall before painting and clean any surfaces of substances that could impair bonding of paint. Apply 2 coats of latex based paint to all interior wall, door and trim surfaces.

Special Instructions for interior painting:

- Conference Room repair and patch crack in wall above doorway.
- Storage Room paint only exposed walls. Not necessary to move metal shelving.
- Multi-purpose/Courtroom repair and patch cracks in ceiling and paint flat white
- Main lobby repair and patch cracks in ceiling and paint flat white
- Windows mullions are not required to be painted in any rooms.
- Furniture units made up of lower lateral files and upper wall cabinets do not need to be moved for painting. Other furniture should be moved just enough to allow walls and trim to be painted.

Each Bidder is responsible for inspecting the site and for reading and being thoroughly familiar with the Specifications and related documents. Irregularities affecting work shall be noted and reported to the City prior to beginning work. By signing the Bid, the Bidder certifies that he has investigated the site conditions of the Project, fully satisfied himself of the conditions, and has based his Bid accordingly. The failure or omission of any Bidder to do any of the foregoing shall in no way relieve any Bidder from any obligation in respect to his Bid.

It is expected that the work for this project shall commence as soon as possible after the contract is awarded by the Board of Commissioners at their February 20, 2019 meeting. The project must be fully completed within 30 days or less. Allowable working days are defined as Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Approval must be given by the Public Works Director for Saturday work. No work is allowed on Sunday.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any one or all bids received. No bidder may withdraw a submitted Bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date set for the opening of bids.

The Owner may make such investigations as he deems necessary to determine the ability of the Bidder to perform the Work, and the Bidder shall furnish to the Owner all such information and data for this purpose as the Owner may request. The Owner reserves the right to reject any Bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of such Bidder fails to satisfy the Owner that such Bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the Agreement and to complete the Work contemplated therein.

Quality Assurance - Workmanship is subject to the City's inspection and approval as the job progresses.

Contractor Requirements:

All Bidders must be licensed contractors as required by the "Contractors Licensing Act of 1976," TCA Title 62, Chapter 6, passed March 18, 1976 by the General Assembly of the State of

Tennessee, and any subsequent amendments thereto, or any Rules and Regulations promulgated by the State Board of Licensing Contractors and approved by proper legal authority. The entire

wording of the Act shall be considered to be included by reference to these documents.

Each Bidder shall submit a minimum of three (3) recent commercial painting references with the sealed bid. Include the location of the work and contact information.

Drug-Free Workplace Affidavits – T.C.A. §50-9-113. Effective January 2001, any contractor with five or more employees who provides construction services for the state or any local government is required to submit an affidavit stating that the contractor has a drug-free workplace program in compliance with the Tennessee Drug-Free Workplace Act, T.C.A. §50-9-101 through 50-0-113. *The Drug-Free Workplace affidavit is to be submitted with the bid for this project.* This statute directs that no local government shall award any construction contract to a contractor who does not submit such an affidavit with its bid.

Iran Divestment Act Certification – The State of Tennessee requires this Certification form to be signed and submitted by every bidder who submits a bid or proposal to the State of Tennessee or the local government entities. *The Iran Divestment Act certification is to be submitted with the bid for this project.*

Insurance Requirements - The Contractor shall procure and maintain for the duration of the contract, at his/her own expense, insurance indicating sufficient Commercial General Liability coverage, with a minimum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence, two million (\$2,000,000.00) aggregate, to protect the Owner and to hold the Owner harmless from any damage or injuries due to the Contractor's negligence and furnish to the City a Certificate of Insurance indicating such coverage. The Contractor is to also furnish a Certificate of Insurance indicating coverage under a Workman's Compensation Policy that meets the State Minimum Requirements. The Contractor is responsible for work-related injuries of the Contractor's employees and subcontractors. The Contractor must provide all equipment and supervision for this contract and assume responsibility for all uninsured subcontractors. The policies described herein shall be issued by insurance companies that are licensed to conduct business in the State of Tennessee. The Contractor must provide a thirty (30) day prior notice of cancellation, non-renewal, or material change in coverage. The policies shall be issued by insurance companies with a Best Rating of not less than B+.
