SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Contractor must be able to provide Bituminous Plant Mix Materials to the requesting departments, which meet or exceed the specifications contained in this document.
- 2. Delivery charge shall include material cost and all costs associated with loading, hauling and unloading. Delivery charge will start at the plant address and end at the closest point to the worksite. Delivery charge will be for a one-way trip. Mapquest.com will be used to determine delivery distance. Delivery charge shall be included in the bid per ton of material delivered.
- 3. Materials shall meet the requirements of Section 401.1 through 401.5 of the latest version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction.
- 4. County Mix Specifications: 3/8 Aggregate (53%), Mansand (23%), Screenings (17%), riversand (7%), RAP (15%), Virgin AC (4.1%) and Total AC (4.9%).
- 5. Franklin County, at its own expense, reserves the right to sample any material, for the purpose of having an independent laboratory test of the material for conformance to specifications. Product that does not meet the specifications listed will cause all of the shipments to be returned at the bidder's expense.
- 6. Contractor is responsible for adjusting asphalt prices according to MoDOT's Asphalt Cement Price Index prior to submitting invoice. Contractor may request to not use MoDOT's Asphalt Cement Price Index by submitting a letter stating same with bid documents.
- 7. Adjustments will be made to the payments due the Contractor for any plant mix bituminous base, plant mix bituminous pavement, plant mix bituminous surface leveling, asphaltic concrete pavement and ultrathin bonded asphalt wearing surface that contains PG64-22, PG70-22 or PG76-22 when it has been determined that the monthly average price for the midpoint of the published prices of PG64-22 for St. Louis, Missouri area and Kansas City area has fluctuated from the monthly average price of the month of the project was bid. The St. Louis, Missouri area and Kansas City area prices will be obtained from the Asphalt Weekly Monitor® published by Poten & Partners Inc. The monthly bas price will be the price from the last published Asphalt Weekly Monitor® prior to the bid opening. The monthly base price, established prior to the monthly bid opening, shall apply to payment estimates for the following month.

8. The adjusted contract unit price will be applied to the actual amount of asphalt binder. The percentage of virgin asphalt, as shown in the job mix formula, will be the basis for adjustments for any asphalt mix purchased during the monthly index period. The

effective asphalt obtained from the use of Recycled Asphalt Pavement (RAP) and/or Recycled Asphalt Shingles (RAS) will not be eligible for adjustment. The base price index for PG64-22 will be applied to the asphalt mix for mixes using PG64-22, PG70-22 or PG76-22

9. To determine the adjustment for any material specified in this provision the following formula will be used.

$$A = (B \times C) \times (D-E)$$

Where: A = Adjustment for mix placed during monthly average index period

B = Tons of Mix Placed during the monthly average index period

C = % of virgin asphalt binder as listed in the job mix formula in use

D = monthly average price at time mix placement

E = monthly average price at time of bid

10. Delivery tickets must show the percent of asphalt. If percent of asphalt is not shown then the tickets will be returned unpaid- to be resubmitted with correct information.

11. Any price change shall be submitted in writing to Franklin County.

The contents of this section include mandatory requirements that will be required of the successful bidder and subsequent contractor. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The Contractor shall furnish County with a certificate of insurance indicating proof of the following insurance from company's license in the State of Missouri:
 - A. Worker's Compensation and Employers' Liability: Worker's Compensation Statutory in compliance with the Compensation law of the Sate and Employers' Liability Insurance with a limit no less than \$1,000,000.00 each accident.
 - B. Comprehensive or Commercial General Liability with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, \$3,000,000.00 aggregate combined Single Limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability. This insurance shall include, but not be limited to, the following coverage.
 - 1. Premises Operations
 - 2. Products and Completed Operations
 - 3. Broad Form Property Damage
 - 4. Contractual
 - 5. Personal Injury
 - C. Automobile Liability with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, \$3,000,000.00 aggregate Combined Single Limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability. This insurance shall include coverage for all the following:
 - 1. Owned Automobiles
 - 2. Hired Automobiles
 - 3. Non-Owned Automobiles
 - D. The certificate shall list the Certificate Holder and Address as follows: Franklin County, 400 E Locust Street, Room 206, Union, Mo 63084. The services provided to Franklin County shall be listed under "Description of Operations."
 - E. Such insurance shall include under the General Liability and Automobile Liability policies Franklin County, its employees, elected officials, representatives, and members of its board and/or commissioners as "Additional Insured's".

2. The Agreement of Insurance shall provide for notice to the County of amendment or cancellation of insurance policies 30 days before such amendment or cancellation is to take effect.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

1. E-Verify

Completion of Affidavit of Work Authorization and provide acceptable documentation of enrollment in the program.

- 2. Employment of Unauthorized Aliens Prohibited
 - a.) Vendor agrees to comply with Missouri Revised Statute Section 285.530.1 in that it shall not knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien to perform work within the State of Missouri.
 - b.) As a condition for the award of this contract, the Vendor shall, by sown affidavit and provision of documentation, affirm its enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees working in connection with the contracted services. The Vendor shall also sign an affidavit affirming that it does not knowingly employ any person who is an unauthorized alien in connection with the contracted services.
 - c.)
