

CITY OF ANTIGO ASPHALT AND CONCRETE CRUSHING

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

1. **SCOPE OF WORK:** The work provided for in these Specifications will consist of furnishing all labor, materials and equipment and performing all work necessary to accomplish asphalt crushing at the City of Antigo's Bryne St stock pile site.
2. **PLANS:** There are no drawn plans for this work.
3. **WORKING DAY LIMITATIONS:** Shall be determined by the City Engineering Dept.
4. **MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS:**
 - 4.1. **Equipment:** Contractor shall provide all necessary equipment to crush and move the material as needed. 1" screen size shall be used in crusher.
 - 4.2. **Limits of Work:** The stock pile area has some residents living near the site. Work shall be completed during normal business hours including Saturday; no work shall be done on Sundays. Once work has begun it shall continue until complete. Completion date will be December 31, 2020
 - 4.3. **Method of Payment:** Payment shall be the contractor's percentage of the asphalt material as bid. The City of Antigo Engineering Dept. shall determine the percentage of the asphalt material left for the City based on the winning bid.
 - 4.4. **Removal of the Contractor Material:** No asphalt material is to be removed until the crushing is complete and the City Engineering department has mark out the percentage of the pile. The contractor shall have 90 days after crushing is complete to remove their portion of the material. Any material left on site after the 90 days will be considered owned by the City of Antigo. Loading and trucking of the contractor's material is the responsibility of the contractor. The City of Antigo will be responsible for removing their portion of the material.
5. **INSURANCE:** The Contractor shall not commence work under this contract until he/she has obtained all insurance required under this agreement and such insurance has been approved by the City. Nor shall the Contractor allow any subcontractor to commence work on this subcontract until all similar insurance required of the subcontractor has been so obtained and approved.

The City of Antigo must be named as an additional insured with a copy of the endorsement forwarded to the City Clerk-Treasurer's Office. No insurance shall be canceled without notifying the City in writing thirty (30) days prior to cancellation.
