Installation of new flooring at the Police Department.

Minimum Bid Specifications

- Install approximately 3000 sq ft of LVT or engineered floors glued down
- 20 MIL required
- Tear carpet out in some areas where new floors as to be installed
- 850 linear feet of four-inch rubber baseboard installed
- Move furniture where needed to install new flooring
- 60 linear feet of rubber reducers for doorways where carpet is staying.
