If it becomes necessary to revise or amend any part of this bid, an addendum will be issued and will be posted on the County's website at <http://www.co.okeechobee.fl.us/>. It is the sole responsibility of the bidders to check the website to ensure that all available information has been received prior to submitting a bid.

A NON-MANDATORY pre-bid conference will be held at the **Okeechobee County Historic Courthouse, Room 201 located at 304 NW 2nd Street, Okeechobee, FL 34972 on August 30, 2017 at 2:00 pm.** Bidder's attendance is **Non-Mandatory**.

Each bid must be accompanied by an acceptable Bid Security in the form of a Bid Bond, or Certified Check, made payable to "Okeechobee County Board of County Commissioners", in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total Bid Amount. The Bidder, if awarded the Contract and the bid amount is \$100,000 or more, will execute and file acceptable performance and payment bonds equal to 100% of the contract price within ten (10) days after written notice of the award of contract. No bidder may withdraw their bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date set for opening of bids.

Okeechobee County accepts no responsibility for any expense related to preparation or delivery of proposals. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, accept Bids in any order or combination, accept or reject portions of Bids, make modifications to the work after bidding, and waive any formality in the Bids if they deem it in their best interest to do so. The General Contractor will provide additional information including, but not limited to, a list of similar projects constructed within the past five (5) years, client references, or other

- (b) BIDDER has familiarized themselves with the nature and extent of the Contract Documents, Work, Site, locality and all local conditions and Law and Regulations that in any manner may affect cost, progress, performance or furnishing of the work.
- (c) BIDDER has studied carefully all reports and drawings of subsurface conditions and drawings of physical conditions.
