Jones County is requesting and will accept sealed bids for the purchase and installation of three (3) new generators until Thursday, July 12, 2018, at 10:30 a.m. local time, by Jason Rizner, County Administrator, at the Jones County Government Center, 166 Industrial Boulevard, Gray, GA 31032 at which time they shall be opened and read aloud. The bids submitted shall not be subject to public inspection until the contract is awarded. Any contract resulting from a bid received shall be awarded to the person or entity that submits the best overall bid as determined by the awarding authority.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, Jones County reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive technicalities and to select the bid that is in the best interest of Jones County.

General Information

The Jones County Board of Commissioners is accepting bids for the purchase and installation of a three new natural gas generators to be installed on wells that are part of the county-owned and operated Haddock water system. Two of the generators will be single-phase – one to be installed at the well location near the old Idella Duncan School and one to be installed at the well location near the intersection of Georgia Highway 22 and Etheridge Road. The third generator will be three phase. The three-phase generator will be installed at the well site just east of "downtown" Haddock on Georgia Highway 22. There is an Add Alternate for diesel models. All other specifications except fuel type apply to the Add Alternate.

The equipment proposed by vendors shall be new and from the most current model year.

Vendors should submit detailed information about their ability to service the generators after installation.

Vendors must provide affidavit verifying status for County Public Benefits and Contractors E-Verify Affidavit with the submittal of the bid as applicable (see attached).

Terms and Conditions

- The County reserves the right to reject and or all bids or proposals, to waive technicalities, and to make a selection and final award as deemed to be in the best interest of the County.
- Provider selection will be based on the information contained in the bids, and incomplete or inaccurate information may result in disqualification of a proposal or a bidder.
- The Jones County Board of Commissioners reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to solicit additional bids, or to amend or revise bid documents.



- The proposal submitted by each proposed service provider will be treated as best and final. There will be no opportunity to negotiate fees during the selection process.
