INVITATION TO BID

Pursuant to North Carolina General Statutes §143-131, the City of Havelock invites informal bids on the following:

Bids must be submitted in accordance with the attached specifications. Bids must include an itemized schedule (including quantity, unit price and total) for each work element. Bids can be submitted by mail, email, fax or hand delivered. Cover sheets, envelopes, etc. should be clearly marked with the words:

Bids will be accepted until **3:00 PM (EST) on Wednesday, September 5, 2018** at which time they will be reviewed in the office of the City Finance Director. Quotes are not subject to public inspection until the contract is awarded. The bids are good for 75 days after opening.

Bidders are cautioned not to submit bids until the proposed requirements and specifications have been carefully examined. It will be considered that bidders will have satisfied themselves as to the accuracy of the specifications. No proposal will be considered unless prices are submitted for all items requested in any section. The City reserves the right to change the amount of quantities.

The names of certain brands or makes denote quality standard in the article desired, but do not restrict bidders to the specific brand, make or manufacturer named. They are meant to convey to prospective bidders the general style, type, character and quality of the article desired.

The successful bidder on all construction contracts will be required to conduct the operation in accordance with all Federal, State, and Municipal health and safety rules, regulations and laws applicable to the operation. The successful bidder may be asked to provide the City with a copy of the company's safety plan prior to commencing work. For all projects over \$30,000, a general contractor's license must be furnished to the City if applicable.



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N.C.G.S. (North Carolina General Statutes), specifically §160A-20.1(b), prohibit the City from entering into contracts with contractors and subcontractors who have not complied with the requirement of Article 2 or Chapter 64. The Contractor shall submit the E-Verify Affidavit, located in the Bid Proposal section, with their bid. Bids that do not include this Affidavit will be considered non-responsive.

N.C.G.S 147-86.42-84 requires that contractors with a North Carolina Local Government must not utilize any subcontractor found on the State Treasurer's Iran Divestment list or Companies Boycotting Israel list. The referenced lists can be found on the State Treasurer's website at the address www.nctreasurers.com and will be updated every 180 days.

The City of Havelock reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to purchase items from the state contract in the efforts to award the contract to the bidder it deems to be for the best interest of the City.

Scope of work

- Prospective bidders are highly recommended to visit site prior to submitting proposals. Sight visit date will be set at time of advertisement of job.
- Building will remain open and occupied during regular operating hours. Contractor will have access during those hours. Regular working hours are 0730 to 1530 Monday through Friday.
- Preconstruction conference will be required. Date will be set after notice to proceed.
- Discuss safety equipment –working perimeters-dumpster placement-porta-john that is to be provided by contractor for the durations of contracted work.
- Remove old roof to metal decking (metal decking to remain) and dispose of all demo debris. Contractor shall provide water tight roof during construction period.
- Roof section 1- Inspect all metal decking and replace all damaged decking not suitable for new roof system. Notify owner immediately of hidden damage, for immediate inspection and verification prior to removal of damaged areas. Contractor to provide price per square foot for materials and labor for repairs for hidden damage before starting job.
- Install ¼ “per foot taper polyisocyanurate insulation minimum thickness 1.5” for positive roof drainage to existing roof drains. Insulation shall be compatible with roof manufacturers system.
- Roof section 2 has a plywood deck. Replace any damaged deck with same materials.
- Replace outside roof drain domes.
- Install a Firestone or equal too, white 060 TPO membrane roof system fully adhered with heat welded seams according to manufactures specifications. Contractor must be licensed or certified installer of roof system manufacture.
- Fabricate and install 24-gauge metal edging, drip leg to extend a minimum of 6” with hemmed exposed edge.

- Provide and install an aluminum roof access ladder by roof blowers. Ladder design shall meet current OSHA and local safety and building codes for its intended use.
- Provide walk pads that lead to the 3 blower units continuous from the access ladder. Filter side only of blower.
- Remove one existing roof fan and curb to metal deck. Fan will be marked for removal.
Remove electrical to nearest junction box. Fill hole with matching corrugated metal, same profile as existing. Overlap edges with metal of 6" minimum and mechanically attach to existing metal.
- Reposition and refasten 2 perimeter concrete fascia panels that have shifted.
- Remove and replace all existing sealant between all vertical joints on existing fascia panels. All areas to be sealed against water intrusion.
- Remove all loose and flaking paint on fascia panels. Prep for new paint system, one coat of sealer primer and two finish coats of industrial white exterior latex paint.
- Roof section 3 has no protrusion, but it is a rock roof over with precast concrete panels. Same specifications apply for that section, as well.
- Contractor to provide all tools and equipment for the job.
- Contractor shall comply with all local and state building codes as well as all OSHA safety code.
- Remove all trash and clean working area.
- Contractor shall provide a 2-year workmanship warranty.
- Need at least a 20-year labor and materials warranty by manufacturer of roof system. Contractor shall submit shop drawings to owner for all roof penetrations, roof flashing details. Provide details for curb flashing for all roof mounted mechanical equipment to remain.
