REQUEST FOR BIDS

RFB 2018-020 Senior Center Storage Building – Design & Build

THE PROJECT: The Cherokee County Board of Commissioners Purchasing Department (County) is requesting competitive sealed \boxtimes Bids or \square Proposals in support for a Federally funded project from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through its Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program for the design and build of a storage building meeting the specifications listed in the statement of work as described herein.

There \boxtimes will be a mandatory meeting to review the requirements. The meeting will be held at the proposed work site located at 1001 Univeter Road Canton, Georgia 30115 and will include walking the area. The meeting will occur at <u>10:00 AM on January 17, 2018.</u>

The term of Agreement(s) resulting from this solicitation can be found in the Statement of Work.

All times in the solicitation are local times to Cherokee County Board of Commissioners, 1130 Bluffs Parkway, Canton, Georgia 30114.

The County reserves the right to reject any or all bids/proposals, to waive technicalities and to make a selection and final award as deemed to be in the best interest of the County, including using any form of contract it deems most advantageous to the County. The County further reserves the right to reject the bid of any vendor who has previously failed to perform properly or complete on time contracts of a similar nature, or who upon investigation shows is not in a position to perform the contract. The base period of performance is broken down into two areas; Physical Delivery of Product(s) and Service Delivery. This is a function of the Statement of Work (SOW) and/or specification and reflects if there is physical item or items to be delivered and / or delivery of services. STATEMENT OF WORK LOCATED ON THE NEXT PAGE

STATEMENT OF WORK:

Cherokee County is seeking a firm to design and build the following structure:

A 1500-1800 sq. ft. approx. 30'x 50' or 30'x60' warehouse style wooden stick built building with some poured concrete walls to be fully insulated and air conditioned/heated. Cherokee County desires an open floor plan with minimum 14' ceilings with gable roof trusses with only one lockable storage (can be chain link fence) area in the building approximately 300 sq. ft. in size. The building should have minimum 10x9 commercial coil door with an operator and remotes and one entry man door with canopy/cover. The hardware for the doors should be compatible with the Schlage Everest D series cores. The interior walls shall consist of 3/4" A-C sanded plywood with batten strips to cover the joints. The floor shall be sealed concrete with a smooth finish. Shelving shall be provided by contractor. Exterior of building to be R Panel 26-gauge metal with a metal roof system with the front facing the driveway made of brick to match the existing Senior Center. Gutters and downspouts will be required with some additional underground piping of water away from the building. The design/build contractor will be responsible for bringing power to the building (minimum 200 amp service) for lighting, outlets, and heating/air conditioning purposes. A conduit pathway consisting of at least 2-4" conduits shall be installed to the exterior of the existing Senior Center building. Above adequate LED lighting will be required as the building interior will have no natural light. LED Security lighting should be included near any exterior entry point. There will be no need to access water or plumbing for the building. Concrete walkways shall be required to any exterior entry point. Bollards will be required near the building at the roll up door.


The building will be constructed at 1001 Univeter Rd, Canton GA 30115 in the hillside directly to the left rear side (northwest) of the Senior Center, above the rear parking area (see Exhibit A for aerial site map [not to scale] and proposed building location). An As-built survey will be required upon completion of the project. Any surveying deemed necessary is the responsibility of the design/build contractor. All access points will be required to be ADA accessible. The design/build firm(s) will be required to obtain all necessary permits and utility meters necessary. Some grading and tree removal will be required. The County may request the contractor stockpile excess soil on the adjacent stockyard. The site footprint of the proposed building site should be **less than one acre** so no NOI will be required, however the project will require an erosion control permit which may include water quality measures.
