**SUBJECT**: Purchase of Temperature Screening Kiosks

#### **Summary**

The Operations Department is seeking to issue a purchase order for temperature screening kiosks for the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 utilizing COVID-19 funds.

#### Background

The Operations Department in conjunction with the Procurement Department is seeking approval to purchase 75 temperature screening kiosks from Audio Engineering.

The Procurement Department released a RFQ for temperature screening kiosks on July 15, 2020. The Sealed Quote closed on July 20, 2020 and there were 13 respondents. The recommendation is based off the compatibility with the current district network communication system as well as the storage capacity that is needed here at the district. The quote received from Audio Engineering has each system priced at \$1,950.00 per unit.







Commercial General and Umbrella Liability Insurance

The Contractor shall procure and shall maintain commercial general liability (CGL) and if necessary, commercial umbrella insurance with a limit of not less than \$250,000 each occurrence, as shall protect him and any Subcontractor performing Work covered by this Contract from claims for damages for bodily injury, including



accidental death, as well as from claims for property damages, which may arise from operations under the Contract Agreement, whether such operations are by himself or by any Subcontractor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by either of them.
