Subject: Recommendation for Final Selection for the ISO Fire Hydrant Flow Testing and Inspection Program (RFQP#1801-11)

ISSUE SUMMARY:

The final selection for this procurement has been completed. Results of the RFQ process are attached with final selection based on interviews between the two shortlisted candidates. You should notify the participants as needed and close out the procurement on the Vendor Registry website.

RECOMMENDATION:

At the March 6, 2018 Board Meeting, the Commissioners authorized the Department to prepare a contract agreement with DMD Consultants, Inc., Mosheim, TN for the Work. The Board also authorized the Chairman to execute the proposed contract on behalf of the County

Results of the shortlist interviews leading up to this determination follow.

- 1st: DMD Consultants, Inc., Mosheim, TN
- 2nd: M.E. Simpson Co. & Giant, Inc., Valparaiso, IN

Staff will submit the proposed contract with a corresponding not-to-exceed budget to the County Administrator for execution by the Chairman.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The Work will be funded from the Department's Renewal and Replacement Fund which, in turn is funded by rate revenue and water availability fees.

ANALYSIS:

The work will be high profile as it impacts water quality, customer relations and public safety.
