SUBJECT: Addendum #1 to INFQ # 34662, Mechanical Vegetation Services L75 and Fellsmere E

As a result of inquiries, the following clarifications/changes are provided for your information. Please make all appropriate changes to your bid documents. Note: changes are reflected with original language shown with strike-through and new language is underlined.

- Q1: Regarding Site 3, is the engineering requesting that the mechanical treatment be performed from the hardened levee or from the bench of the ditch?
- A1: The equipment is allowed to work from the slope or the hardened levee top. The decision is up to the discretion of the contractor but any damage due to the work is the responsibility of the contractor to repair.
- Q2: The ditch appears to be unsafe for equipment to operate in, and the equipment listed may not reach the vegetation from the top of the levee, and per the bid specifications and equipment requested, it may be unable to be completed. Will this result in a disqualification or underperformance of the bid project?
- A2: The equipment listed is an example of the equipment that has been used in the past. The equipment and method of the contractor is up to their discretion as long as it meets the required deliverables.
- Q3: What is the current water level?
- A3: The current water levels in that area are around 22.8 NAVD88.
- Q4: What is the anticipated water level trend from past years?
- A4: The water levels in that area are currently controlled to around 23.03 NAVD88 so it should not go up much over that number until after the contract period is over.
