THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION SHALL BE INCORPORATED AS PART OF THIS SOLICITATION:

The District will consider alternate brand name equipment.

BRAND NAME OR EQUAL SPECIFICATION: The use of a “brand name or equal” specification which uses one or more manufacturer’s names or catalogue numbers to describe the standard of quality, performance and other characteristics needed to meet District requirements, and which provides for the submission of equivalent products. Brand name or equal specifications are not intended to limit or restrict competition. An item shall be considered to be substantially equivalent, or “equal” to the specified brand if in the opinion of the Procurement Officer, the District can reasonably anticipate sufficiently similar quality, capacity, durability, performance, utility and productivity as provided by the specified brand. Your offer must include manufacturer’s latest literature showing complete product specifications if bidding on other than specified. Failure to include descriptive literature may be reason for rejection of your bid.

The Districts decision as to acceptance of the product as equal shall be final.
